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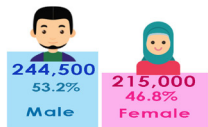
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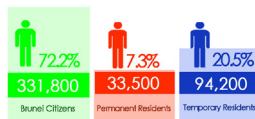


POPULATION 2019

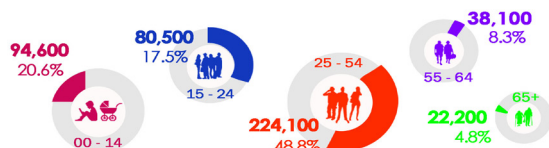
Population by SEX



Population by RESIDENTIAL STATUS



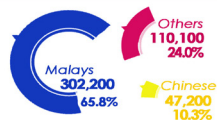
Population by AGE GROUP



Population by DISTRICT



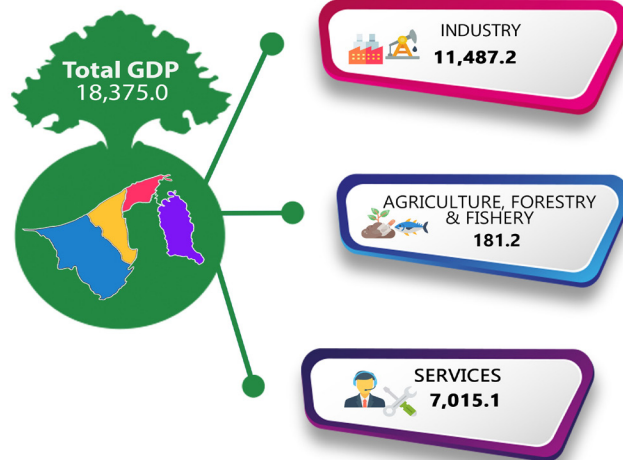

by Economic Activities at Current Prices

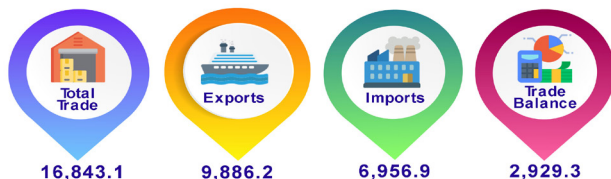
