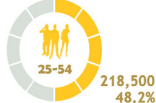
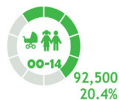
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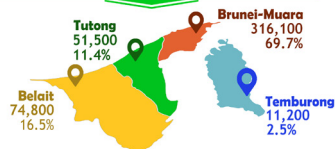
### RESIDENTIAL STATUS



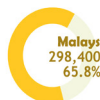

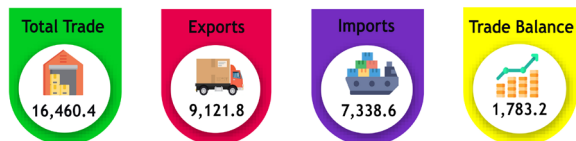

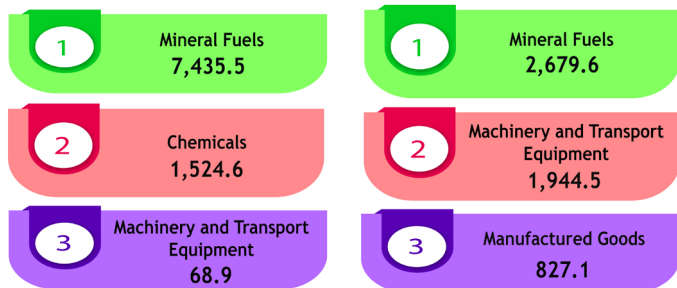


## INTERNATIONAL MERCHANDISE TRADE STATISTICS 2020

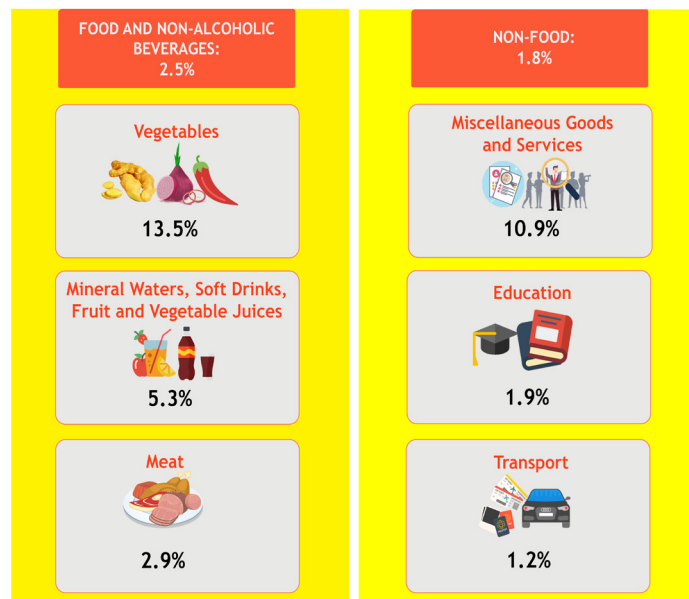
### Top 3 Commodities
