

INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA (IHP), OGOS 2017

1. Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) bagi bulan Ogos 2017 menurun sebanyak 0.1 peratus tahun-ke-tahun berbanding bulan Ogos 2016. Indeks Bukan Makanan mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 0.2 peratus manakala Indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 0.6 peratus tahun-ke-tahun.
2. Penurunan IHP bagi bulan Ogos 2017 sebahagian besarnya disebabkan oleh penurunan Indeks Pakaian dan Kasut (3.6 peratus); Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah (2.6 peratus); dan Pelbagai Barang dan Perkhidmatan (0.6 peratus). Ini adalah berikutan harga yang lebih rendah pada Indeks Pakaian dan Kasut adalah disebabkan oleh penurunan harga bagi bahan untuk pakaian, kebanyakan pakaian dan baju serta kasut. Manakala, penurunan harga Indeks Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah bagi perabot dan perhiasan, tekstil isi rumah dan kelengkapan isi rumah. Indeks Pelbagai Barang dan Perkhidmatan menurun adalah disebabkan oleh penurunan harga pada dandanan rambut dan lain-lain produk untuk penjagaan diri.
3. Bagi perubahan tempoh ke tempoh, IHP bagi Januari-Ogos 2017 mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 0.3 peratus berbanding dengan tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan dan Indeks Bukan Makanan masing-masing mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 0.4 peratus dan 0.3 peratus.
4. IHP mengukur perubahan harga barang dan perkhidmatan yang dibayar oleh pengguna dalam satu tempoh masa ditetapkan dan dikumpulkan setiap bulan. Senarai barang dan perkhidmatan dalam IHP adalah berdasarkan maklumat perbelanjaan purata sebuah keluarga yang diperolehi melalui Kajian Perbelanjaan Keluarga. CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI), AUGUST 2017

1. *Consumer Price Index (CPI) in August 2017 decreased by 0.1 per cent year-on-year compared to August 2016. The Non-Food Index decreased by 0.2 per cent meanwhile the Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages Index increased by 0.6 per cent year-on-year.*
2. *The CPI decrease in August 2017 was mainly attributed to decrease in the indices of Clothing and Footwear (3.6 per cent); Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance (2.6 per cent); and Miscellaneous Goods and Services (0.6 per cent). These were mainly due to lower prices of the Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance Index for furniture and furnishings, household textiles and household appliances. Meanwhile, lower Clothing and Footwear Index was due to decrease in the prices of clothing material, most garments as well as shoes and other footwear. Lower Miscellaneous Goods and Services Index was due to lower prices of hairdressing and other products for personal care.*
3. *On a period-on-period basis, CPI in January-August 2017 has decreased by 0.3 per cent compared to the same period last year. Both Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages and Non-Food Index decreased by 0.4 per cent and 0.3 per cent, respectively.*
4. *CPI is a measure of price changes of goods and services paid by the consumer in a specified period and compiled on a monthly basis. The list of goods and services in the CPI is based on the average expenditure per household from the Household Expenditure Survey.
