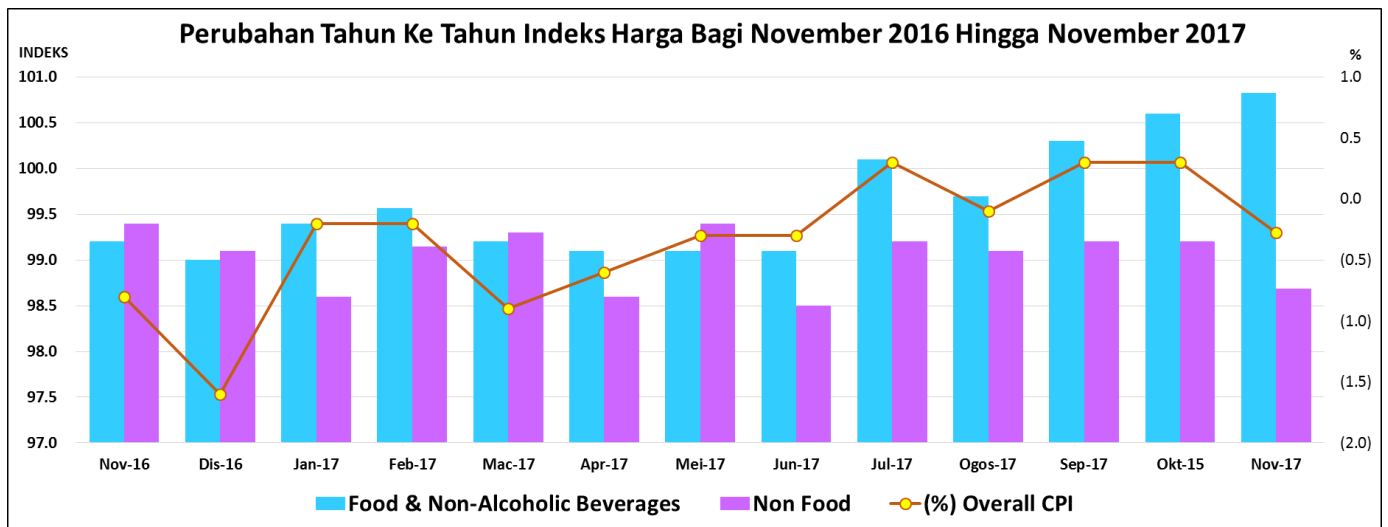

INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA (IHP), NOVEMBER 2017

1. Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) bagi bulan November 2017 menurun sebanyak 0.3 peratus tahun-ke-tahun berbanding bulan November 2016. Indeks Bukan Makanan mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 0.7 peratus, manakala Indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan dan mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 1.6 peratus tahun-ke-tahun.
2. Penurunan IHP bagi bulan November 2017 sebahagian besarnya disebabkan oleh penurunan Indeks Pakaian dan Kasut (5.3 peratus); Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah (3.2 peratus); dan Pelbagai Barangan dan Perkhidmatan (1.7 peratus). Indeks Pakaian dan Kasut menurun terutamanya disebabkan oleh penurunan harga bagi bahan untuk pakaian, pakaian dan baju serta kasut. Manakala, penurunan Indeks Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah adalah disebabkan oleh penurunan harga pada perabot, tekstil isi rumah serta kelengkapan isi rumah. Penurunan Indeks Pelbagai Barangan dan Perkhidmatan adalah disebabkan oleh penurunan harga bagi dandanan rambut, lain-lain produk untuk penjagaan diri serta beg and barangan perjalanan.
3. Bagi perubahan tempoh ke tempoh, IHP bagi Januari-November 2017 mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 0.2 peratus berbanding dengan tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Indeks Bukan Makanan mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 0.2 peratus manakala Indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 0.1 peratus.
4. IHP mengukur perubahan harga barangan dan perkhidmatan yang dibayar oleh pengguna dalam satu tempoh masa ditetapkan dan dikumpulkan setiap bulan. Senarai barangan dan perkhidmatan dalam IHP adalah berdasarkan maklumat perbelanjaan purata sebuah keluarga yang diperolehi melalui Kajian Perbelanjaan Keluarga. CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI), NOVEMBER 2017

1. *Consumer Price Index (CPI) in November 2017 decreased by 0.3 per cent year-on-year compared to November 2016. The Non-Food Index decreased by 0.7 per cent, meanwhile the Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages Index increased by 1.6 per cent year-on-year.*
2. *The CPI decrease in November 2017 was mainly due to decrease in the indices of Clothing and Footwear (5.3 per cent); Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance (3.2 per cent); and Miscellaneous Goods and Services (1.7 per cent). The Clothing and Footwear Index decreases mainly due to lower prices of clothing materials, garments as well as shoes and footwear. Meanwhile, lower Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance Index was due to decrease in prices of furniture, household textiles as well as household appliances. Lower Miscellaneous Goods and Services Index was due to decrease in prices of hairdressing, other articles for personal care and travel goods and bags.*
3. *On a period-on-period basis, CPI in January-November 2017 has decreased by 0.2 per cent compared to the same period last year. The Non-Food Index decreased by 0.2 per cent, meanwhile the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages Index increased by 0.1 per cent.*
4. *CPI is a measure of price changes of goods and services paid by the consumer in a specified period and compiled on a monthly basis. The list of goods and services in the CPI is based on the average expenditure per household from the Household Expenditure Survey.
