TAJUK UTAMA:

INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA MENURUN 0.4 PERATUS BAGI BULAN SEPTEMBER 2024

1. Bagi bulan September 2024, Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) menunjukkan penurunan sebanyak 0.4 peratus berbanding bulan September 2023. Ini adalah didorong oleh penurunan indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan; dan indeks Bukan Makanan masing-masing sebanyak 0.4 peratus dan 0.5 peratus.
2. Penurunan bagi indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan adalah didorong oleh penurunan harga Daging (1.7 peratus), terutamanya harga makanan daging yang berproses; dan harga Minyak dan Lemak (6.4 peratus), terutamanya berikutan penurunan harga minyak masak.
3. Sementara itu, penurunan indeks Bukan Makanan adalah terutamanya disebabkan oleh penurunan harga Perumahan, Air, Elektrik, Gas dan Bahan Api Lain (1.3 peratus), khususnya kos penyelenggaraan dan pembaikan tempat kediaman. Selain itu, harga Pengangkutan (0.7 peratus) juga turut menyumbang kepada penurunan indeks Bukan Makanan, terutamanya bagi harga kenderaan.
4. Bagi perbandingan bulan-ke-bulan, IHP September 2024 menurun sebanyak 0.3 peratus daripada Ogos 2024, berikutan penurunan bagi indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan; dan indeks Bukan Makanan masing-masing sebanyak 0.2 peratus dan 0.3 peratus.
5. Penurunan bagi indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan adalah terutamanya disumbangkan oleh Sayur-Sayuran (1.9 peratus); dan Daging (0.3 peratus). Manakala, penurunan indeks Bukan Makanan adalah terutamanya disumbangkan oleh harga Pengangkutan (1.9 peratus); dan Perumahan, Air, Elektrik, Gas dan Bahan Api Lain (0.3 peratus).
6. IHP mengukur perubahan harga bakul barang dan perkhidmatan yang dibayar oleh pengguna dalam satu tempoh masa yang ditetapkan dan dikumpulkan setiap bulan. Senarai barang dan perkhidmatan dalam IHP adalah berdasarkan maklumat perbelanjaan purata sebuah keluarga yang diperolehi melalui Kajian Perbelanjaan Keluarga. 

MAIN HEADLINE:

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX DECREASED BY 0.4 PER CENT IN SEPTEMBER 2024

1. *In September 2024, the Consumer Price Index (CPI) registered a 0.4 per cent decrease compared to September 2023. This was driven by 0.4 per cent and 0.5 per cent decrease in the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages; and Non-Food indices, respectively.*
2. *The decrease in the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages index was mainly attributed to the fall in processed meat prices under the Meat category (1.7 per cent); and the prices of cooking oils under the Oil and Fats category (6.4 per cent).*
3. *As for the decrease in the Non-Food index, the cost of maintenance and repair of the dwelling was the primary factor in the decline of Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels category (1.3 per cent). In addition, lower prices of motor cars in the Transport category (0.7 per cent) has also contributed to the decrease in the Non-Food index.*
4. *For the month-on-month comparison, the CPI in September 2024 registered a decrease of 0.3 per cent from August 2024. This was due to decreases in both Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages; and Non-Food indices by 0.2 per cent and 0.3 per cent respectively.*
5. *The decrease in the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages index was mainly contributed by Vegetables (1.9 per cent); and Meat (0.3 per cent). As for the Non-Food index, the decrease was mainly driven by the prices of Transport (1.9 per cent); and Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels (0.3 per cent).*
6. *The CPI is a measure of price changes of basket of goods and services paid by the consumer in a specified period and compiled on a monthly basis. The list of goods and services in the CPI is based on the average expenditure per household from the Household Expenditure Survey (HES).
