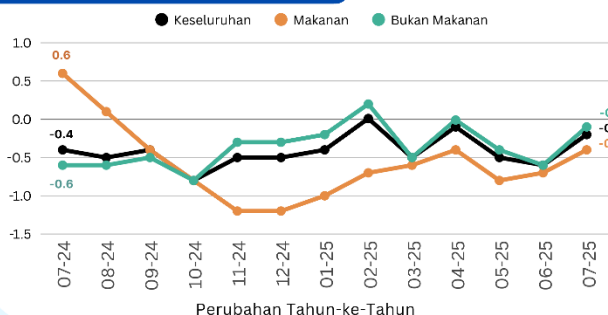

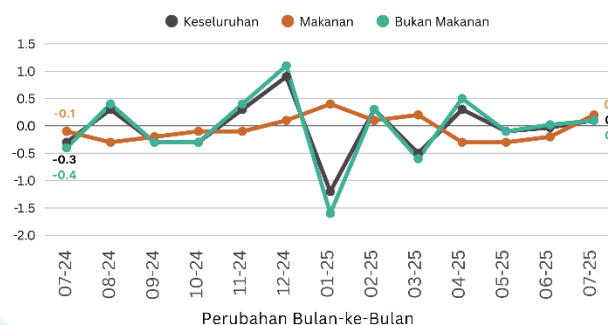

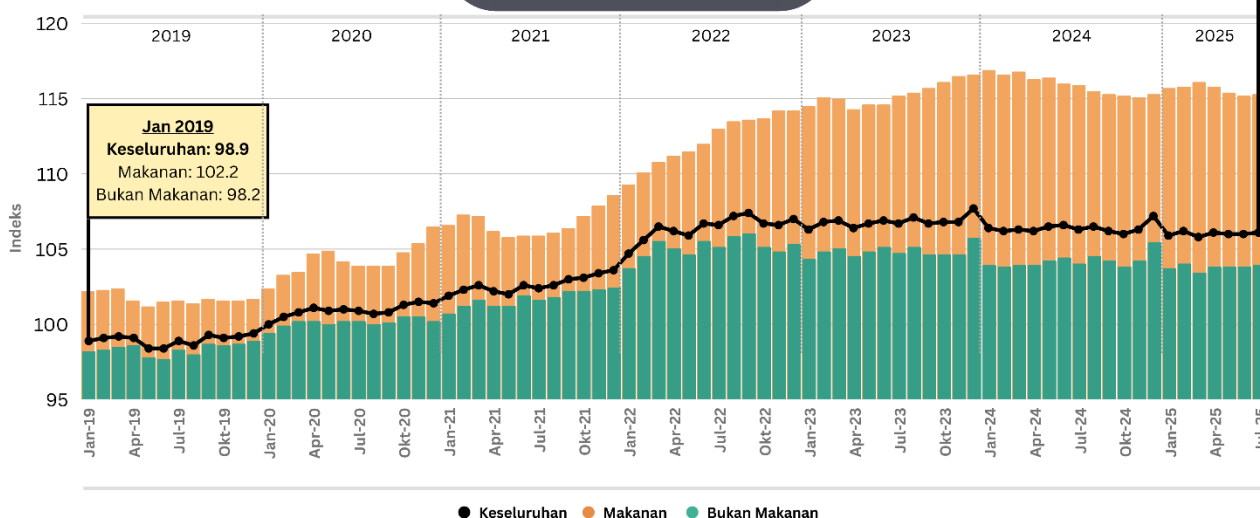

INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA MENURUN 0.2 PERATUS BAGI BULAN JULAI 2025

Perbandingan bulan Julai 2025 dan Julai 2024

1. Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) pada bulan Julai 2025 menunjukkan penurunan sebanyak 0.2 peratus berbanding bulan Julai 2024, didorong oleh penurunan 0.4 peratus bagi indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan; dan 0.1 peratus bagi indeks Bukan Makanan.
2. Penurunan bagi indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan adalah terutamanya disumbangkan oleh penurunan harga Sayur-sayuran (5.3 peratus); dan harga Daging (2.3 peratus), khususnya daging yang berproses.
3. Sementara itu, penurunan bagi indeks Bukan Makanan adalah didorong oleh penurunan kos perkhidmatan langganan penstriman media atas talian disebabkan oleh perbezaan pertukaran matawang asing; dan harga pengangkutan, berikutan penurunan harga tiket penerbangan.

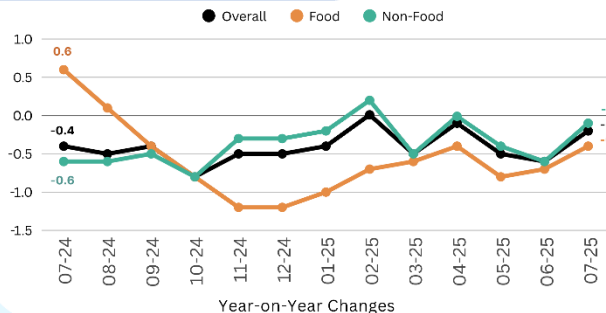
Perbandingan bulan Julai 2025 dan Jun 2025

4. Bagi perbandingan bulan-ke-bulan, IHP Julai 2025 meningkat sebanyak 0.1 peratus daripada Jun 2025. Ini adalah didorong oleh peningkatan sebanyak 0.2 peratus bagi indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan; dan 0.1 peratus bagi indeks Bukan Makanan.
5. Peningkatan bagi indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan adalah terutamanya disumbangkan oleh peningkatan harga Ikan dan Makanan Laut (1.1 peratus); dan Minuman Ringan (0.9 peratus). Manakala, peningkatan bagi indeks Bukan Makanan adalah terutamanya didorong oleh Pakaian dan Kasut (2.8 peratus); dan Restoran dan Hotel (0.1 peratus).
6. IHP mengukur perubahan harga bakul barangan dan perkhidmatan tetap yang dibayar oleh pengguna dalam satu tempoh masa yang ditetapkan dan dikumpulkan setiap bulan. Senarai barangan dan perkhidmatan dalam IHP adalah berdasarkan maklumat perbelanjaan purata sebuah keluarga yang diperolehi melalui Kajian Perbelanjaan Keluarga. 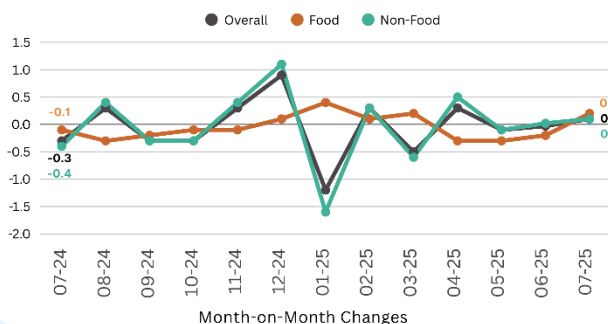


CONSUMER PRICE INDEX JULY 2025

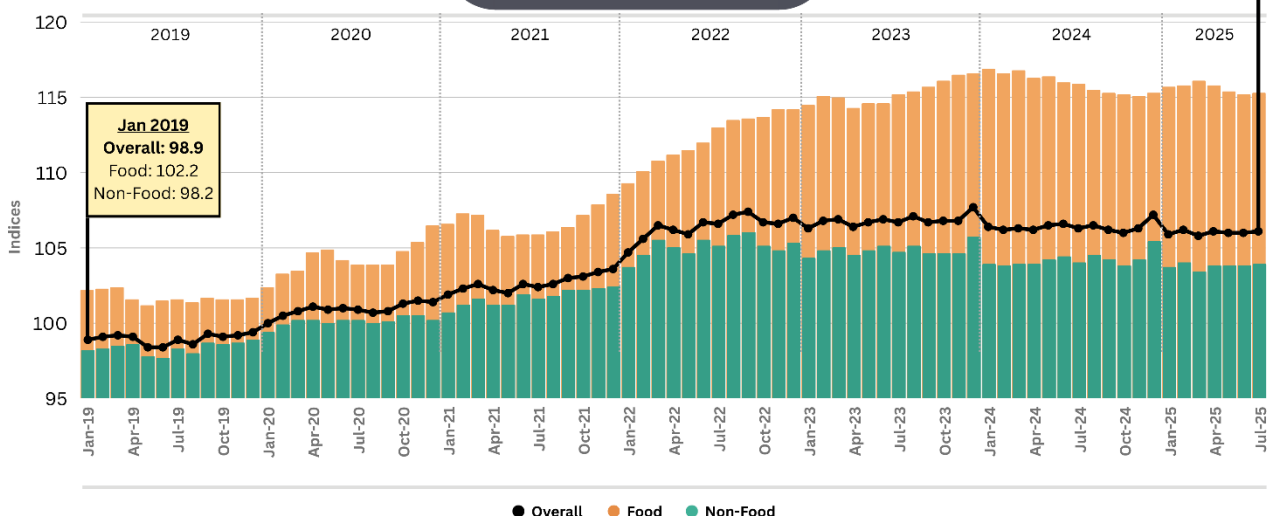

- Month-on-month means to compare prices with the previous month.
- Year-on-year means to compare prices with the same month in the previous year.

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX DECREASED BY 0.2 PER CENT IN JULY 2025

Comparison of July 2025 with July 2024

1. *The Consumer Price Index (CPI) in July 2025 recorded a decrease of 0.2 per cent compared to July 2024, driven by declines of 0.4 per cent in the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages index; and 0.1 per cent in the Non-Food index.*
2. *The decrease in the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages index was mainly contributed by the decline in the prices of Vegetables (5.3 per cent); and Meat (2.3 per cent), mainly meat preparations.*
3. *As for the Non-Food index, the decrease was driven by a decline in the cost of online media streaming subscription services due to exchange rate differences; and transport prices, following a decline in air fare prices.*

Comparison of July 2025 with June 2025

4. *On a month-on-month basis, the CPI in July 2025 increased by 0.1 per cent compared to June 2025. This was driven by increases of 0.2 per cent in the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages index; and a 0.1 increase in the Non-Food index.*
5. *The increase in the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages index was mainly contributed by an increase in the prices of Fish and Seafood (1.1 per cent); and Non-Alcoholic Beverages (0.9 per cent). Meanwhile, the increase in the Non-Food index was driven by the prices of Clothing and Footwear (2.8 per cent); and Restaurants and Hotels (0.1 per cent).*
6. *The CPI is a measure of price changes of a fixed basket of goods and services purchased by consumers in a specified period and compiled on a monthly basis. The list of goods and services in the CPI is based on the average expenditure per household from the Household Expenditure Survey (HES).
