

JUMLAH PERDAGANGAN BAGI BULAN APRIL 2025 MENCATATKAN BND1,938.3 JUTA


1. Jumlah perdagangan bagi bulan April 2025 adalah sebanyak BND1,938.3 juta, yang terdiri daripada eksport berjumlah BND1,167.1 juta dan import berjumlah BND771.2 juta.
2. Penyumbang utama kepada nilai eksport adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 74.6 peratus, diikuti oleh Bahan Kimia sebanyak 23.2 peratus, dan Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 0.7 peratus.

3. Pasaran eksport utama adalah Australia sebanyak 26.8 peratus, diikuti oleh Thailand dan Republik Rakyat China, masing-masing sebanyak 16.1 peratus dan 14.4 peratus. Komoditi eksport terbesar ke negara-negara tersebut adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Bahan Kimia.

Taburan Eksport Mengikut Rakan Dagangan



- Manakala, import pada bulan April 2025 bernilai BND771.2 juta. Tiga komoditi import utama adalah Bahan Api Galian, menyumbang sebanyak 65.7 peratus, diikuti oleh Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 11.9 peratus, dan Makanan sebanyak 8.5 peratus.

Import Utama Mengikut Komoditi



- Sumbangan terbesar rakan dagangan import adalah dari Malaysia sebanyak 16.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Norway sebanyak 14.6 peratus, dan Australia sebanyak 13.1 peratus. Komoditi import utama daripada rakan dagangan adalah Bahan Api Galian, Makanan, dan juga Bahan Kimia.
- Berbanding Mac 2025, jumlah perdagangan menurun sebanyak 3.8 peratus pada bulan April 2025 disebabkan oleh penurunan eksport sebanyak 7.0 peratus.
- Import mengikut kategori penggunaan akhir digunakan untuk pemrosesan Barangan Perantaraan sebanyak 58.1 peratus, diikuti oleh Barangan Modal bagi operasi perniagaan sebanyak 38.3 peratus, dan Barangan Penggunaan bagi kegunaan isi rumah sebanyak 3.6 peratus.



TOTAL TRADE IN APRIL 2025 RECORDED AT BND1,938.3 MILLION

1. The total trade for April 2025 was BND1,938.3 million, comprising exports valued at BND1,167.1 million and imports amounting to BND771.2 million.
2. The major contributors to the export value were Mineral Fuels accounting for 74.6 per cent, followed by Chemicals at 23.2 per cent, and Machinery and Transport Equipment at 0.7 per cent.

Main Exports by Commodity







3. The main export markets were Australia accounting for 26.8 per cent, followed by Thailand and the People's Republic of China at 16.1 per cent and 14.4 per cent, respectively. The largest export commodities to these countries were Mineral Fuels and Chemicals.

4. *Meanwhile, imports in April 2025 were valued at BND771.2 million. The three main import commodities were Mineral Fuels, accounting for 65.7 per cent, followed by Machinery and Transport Equipment at 11.9 per cent, and Food at 8.5 per cent.*

5. *The largest import partners were Malaysia, accounting for 16.9 per cent, followed by Norway at 14.6 per cent, and Australia at 13.1 per cent. The main import commodities from these trading partners were Mineral Fuels, Food, as well as Chemicals.*
6. *Compared to March 2025, the total trade declined by 3.8 per cent in April 2025 due to a 7.0 per cent decrease in exports.*
7. *The imports for end use categories were mainly used as Intermediate Goods processing accounting for 58.1 per cent, followed by Capital Goods for business operations at 38.3 per cent, and Consumption Goods for household use at 3.6 per cent.*
