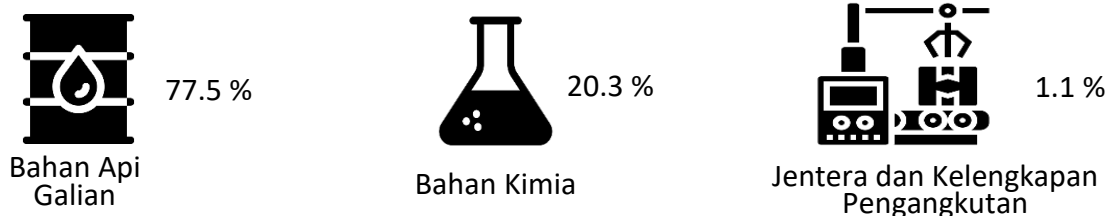

PRESTASI PERDAGANGAN MENINGKAT PADA MAC 2025

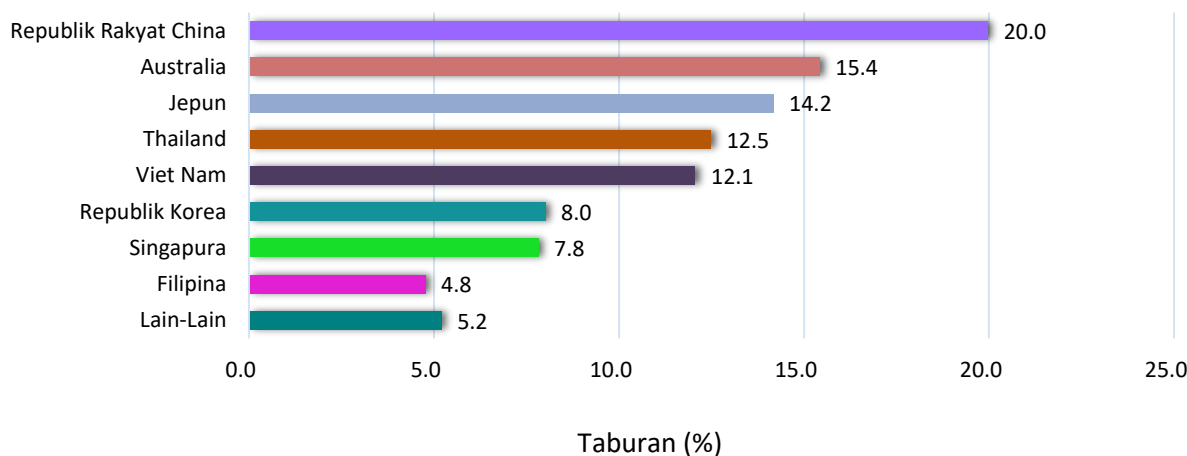
1. Jumlah perdagangan bagi bulan Mac 2025 meningkat sebanyak 12.3 peratus kepada BND2,015.0 juta, berbanding Februari 2025. Ini adalah disumbangkan oleh peningkatan nilai eksport sebanyak 11.1 peratus, berjumlah BND1,255.0 juta dan juga peningkatan pada import sebanyak 14.4 peratus, berjumlah BND760.0 juta.
2. Penyumbang utama kepada nilai eksport adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 77.5 peratus, diikuti oleh Bahan Kimia sebanyak 20.3 peratus, dan Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 1.1 peratus.

3. Pasaran eksport utama adalah Republik Rakyat China sebanyak 20.0 peratus, diikuti oleh Australia dan Jepun, masing-masing sebanyak 15.4 peratus dan 14.2 peratus. Komoditi eksport terbesar ke negara-negara tersebut adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Bahan Kimia.

4. Manakala, import pada bulan Mac 2025 bernilai BND760.0 juta. Tiga komoditi import utama adalah Bahan Api Galian, menyumbang sebanyak 67.5 peratus, diikuti oleh Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 9.4 peratus, dan Makanan sebanyak 8.4 peratus.

5. Sumbangan terbesar rakan dagangan import adalah dari Malaysia sebanyak 27.3 peratus, diikuti oleh Nigeria sebanyak 14.0 peratus, dan Papua New Guinea sebanyak 9.0 peratus. Komoditi import utama daripada rakan dagangan adalah Bahan Api Galian, Makanan dan juga Bahan Kimia.
6. Berbanding Februari 2025, imbalan perdagangan meningkat sebanyak 6.3 peratus pada bulan Mac 2025, terutamanya disebabkan oleh peningkatan eksport sebanyak 11.1 peratus.
7. Import mengikut kategori penggunaan akhir digunakan untuk pemprosesan Barangan Perantaraan sebanyak 59.5 peratus, diikuti oleh Barangan Modal bagi operasi perniagaan sebanyak 36.9 peratus, dan Barangan Penggunaan bagi kegunaan isi rumah sebanyak 3.6 peratus.

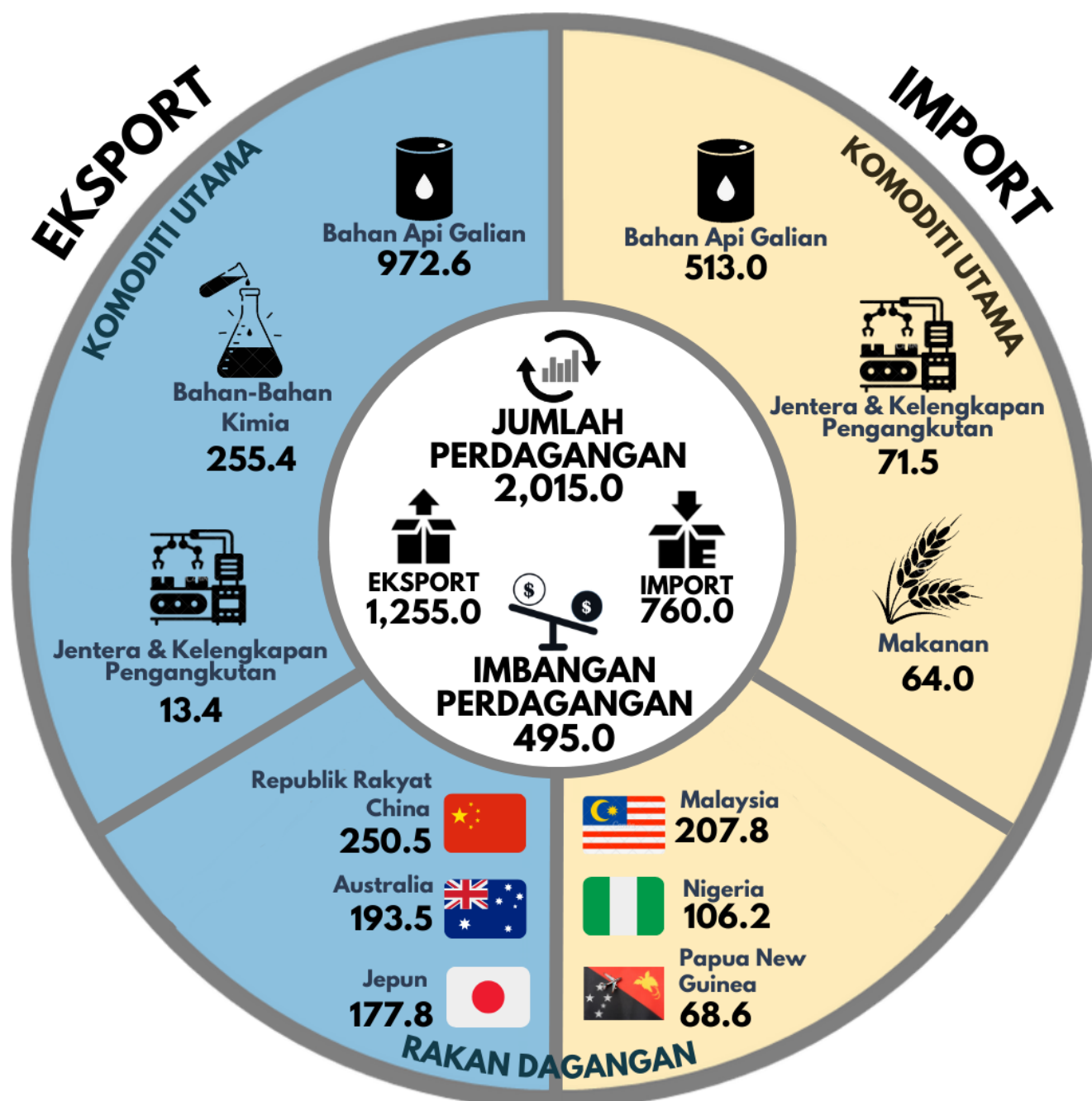

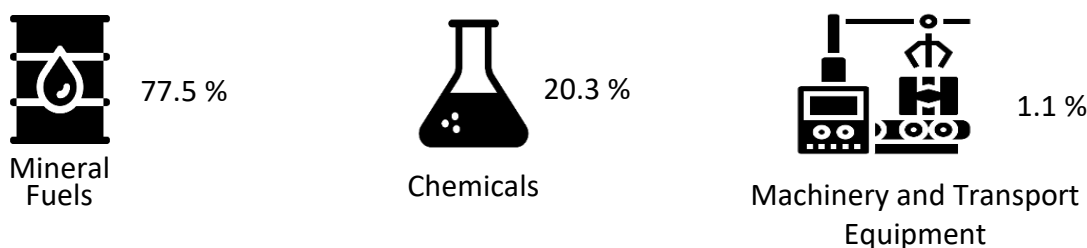

TRADE PERFORMANCE INCREASED IN MARCH 2025

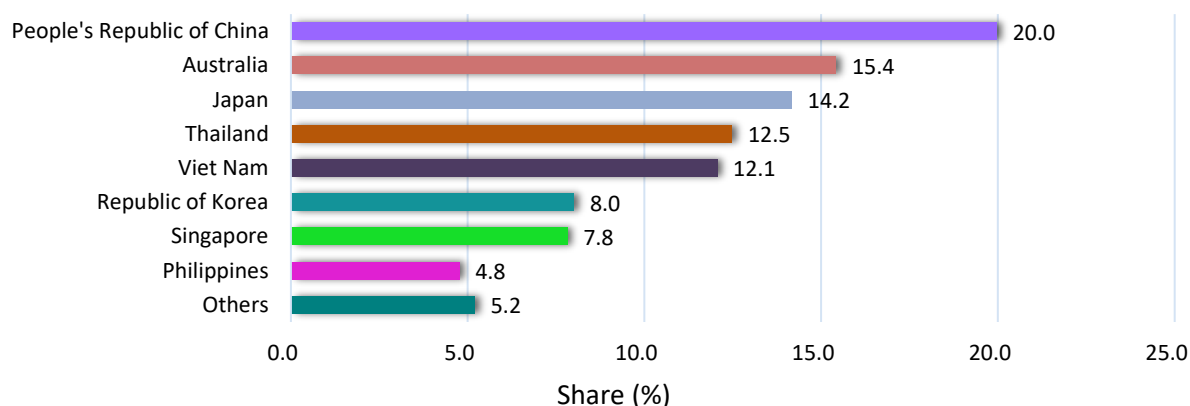
1. The total trade for March 2025 grew by 12.3 per cent to BND2,015.0 million, compared to February 2025. This was primarily driven by the rise in exports by 11.1 per cent, valued at BND1,255.0 million as well as the growth in imports by 14.4 per cent, amounting to BND760.0 million.
2. The major contributors to the export value were Mineral Fuels accounting for 77.5 per cent, followed by Chemicals at 20.3 per cent, and Machinery and Transport Equipment at 1.1 per cent.

Main Exports by Commodity



3. The main export markets were the People's Republic of China accounting for 20.0 per cent, followed by Australia and Japan at 15.4 per cent and 14.2 per cent, respectively. The largest export commodities to these countries were Mineral Fuels and Chemicals.

4. *Meanwhile, imports in March 2025 were valued at BND760.0 million. The three main import commodities were Mineral Fuels, accounting for 67.5 per cent, followed by Machinery and Transport Equipment at 9.4 per cent, and Food at 8.4 per cent.*

5. *The largest import partners were Malaysia, accounting for 27.3 per cent, followed by Nigeria at 14.0 per cent, and Papua New Guinea at 9.0 per cent. The main import commodities from these trading partners were Mineral Fuels, Food as well as Chemicals.*
6. *Compared to February 2025, the trade balance in March 2025 rose by 6.3 per cent, primarily due to an 11.1 percent rise in exports.*
7. *The imports for end use categories were mainly used as Intermediate Goods processing accounting for 59.5 per cent, followed by Capital Goods for business operations at 36.9 per cent, and Consumption Goods for household use at 3.6 per cent.*
