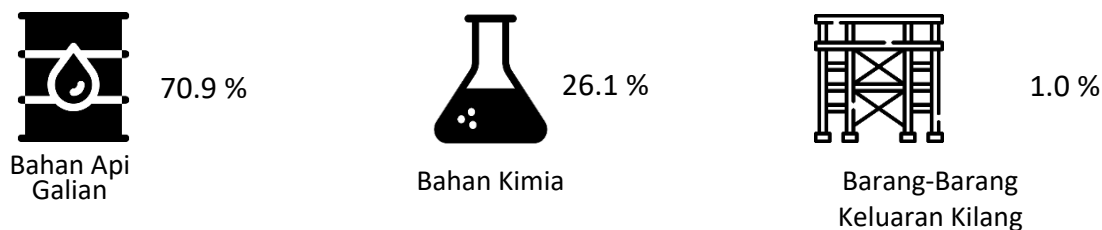

JUMLAH PERDAGANGAN BAGI BULAN MEI 2025 MENCATATKAN BND1,803.5 JUTA

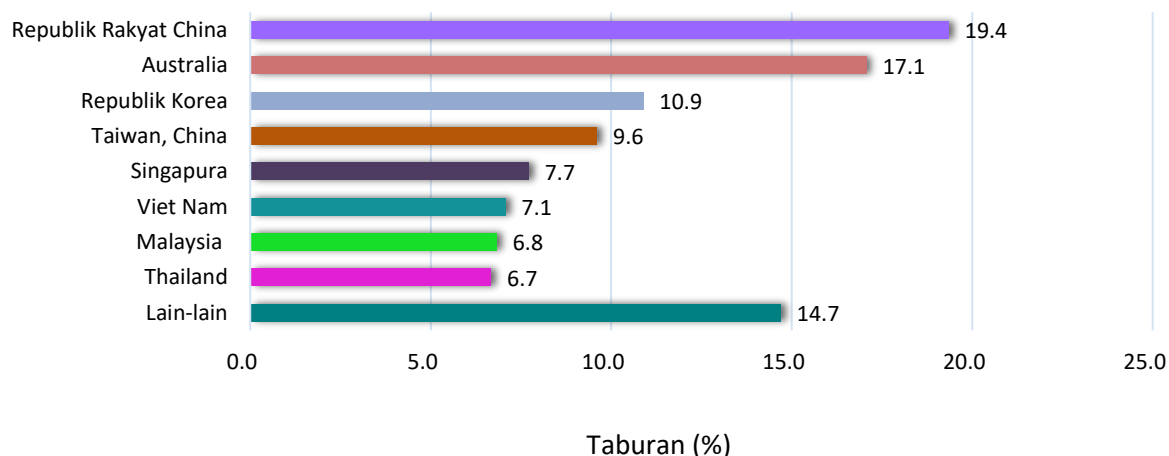
1. Jumlah perdagangan bagi bulan Mei 2025 adalah sebanyak BND1,803.5 juta, yang terdiri daripada eksport berjumlah BND1,027.9 juta dan import berjumlah BND775.6 juta.
2. Penyumbang utama kepada nilai eksport adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 70.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Bahan Kimia sebanyak 26.1 peratus, dan Barang-Barang Keluaran Kilang sebanyak 1.0 peratus.

3. Pasaran eksport utama adalah Republik Rakyat China sebanyak 19.4 peratus, diikuti oleh Australia dan Republik Korea, masing-masing sebanyak 17.1 peratus dan 10.9 peratus. Komoditi eksport terbesar ke negara-negara tersebut adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Bahan Kimia.

4. Manakala, import pada bulan Mei 2025 bernilai BND775.6 juta. Tiga komoditi import utama adalah Bahan Api Galian, menyumbang sebanyak 68.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 9.7 peratus, dan Makanan sebanyak 8.0 peratus.

5. Sumbangan terbesar rakan dagangan import adalah dari Malaysia sebanyak 39.6 peratus, diikuti oleh Republik Rakyat China sebanyak 6.8 peratus, dan Australia sebanyak 4.9 peratus. Komoditi import utama daripada rakan dagangan adalah Bahan Api Galian, Makanan, dan juga Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan.
6. Berbanding April 2025, jumlah perdagangan menurun sebanyak 7.0 peratus pada bulan Mei 2025 disebabkan oleh penurunan eksport sebanyak 11.9 peratus.
7. Import mengikut kategori penggunaan akhir digunakan untuk pemprosesan Barangan Perantaraan sebanyak 58.1 peratus, diikuti oleh Barangan Modal bagi operasi perniagaan sebanyak 38.7 peratus, dan Barangan Penggunaan bagi kegunaan isi rumah sebanyak 3.2 peratus.

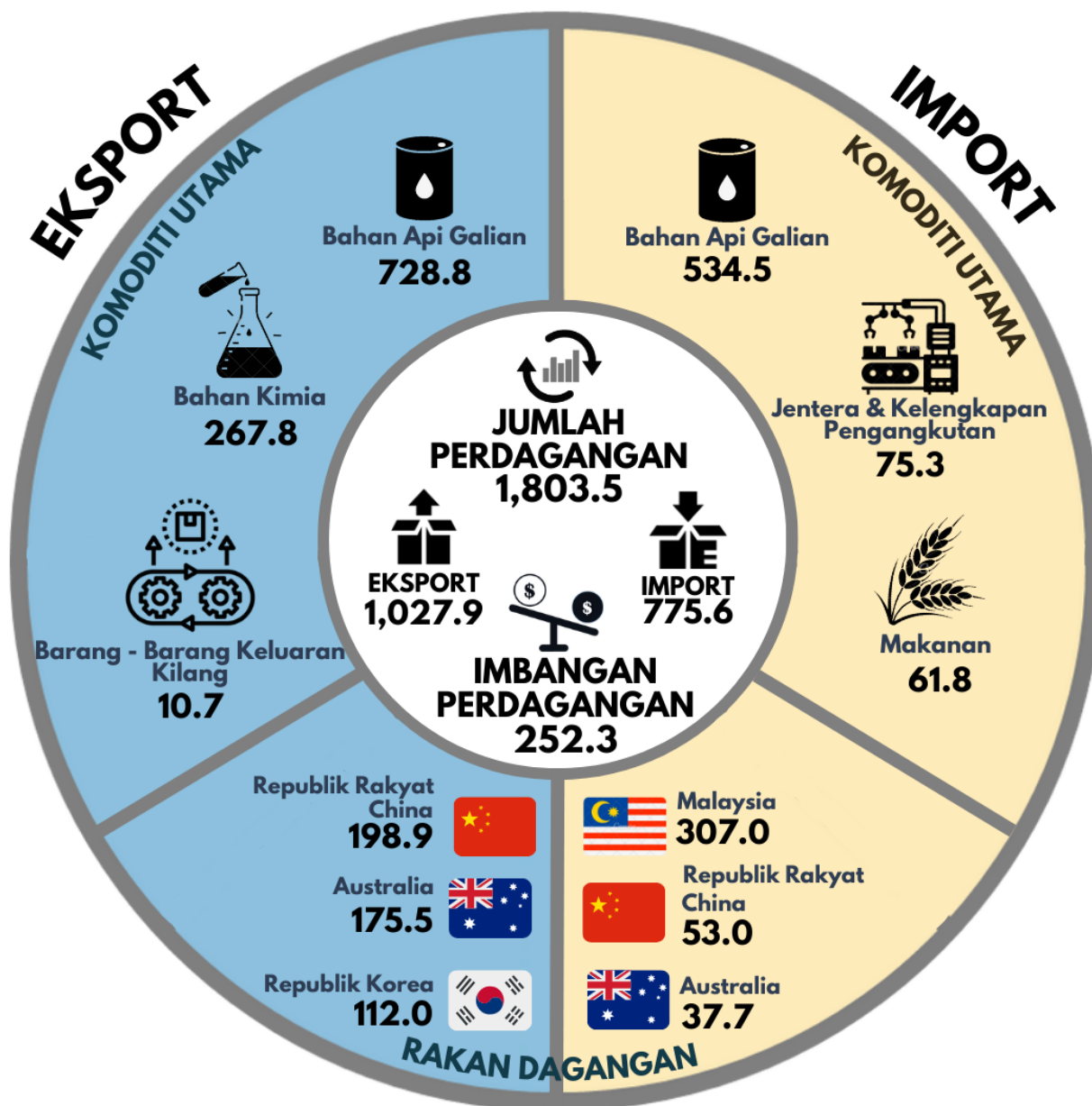

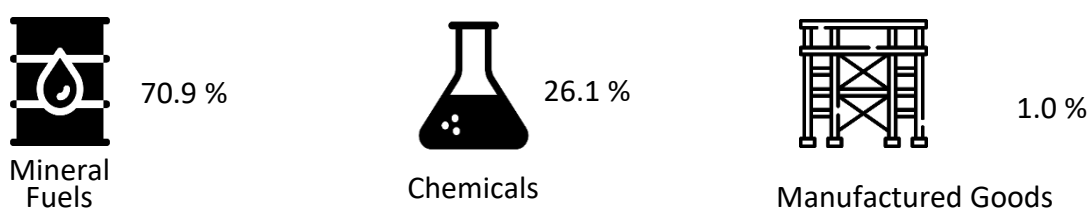

TOTAL TRADE IN MAY 2025 RECORDED AT BND1,803.5 MILLION

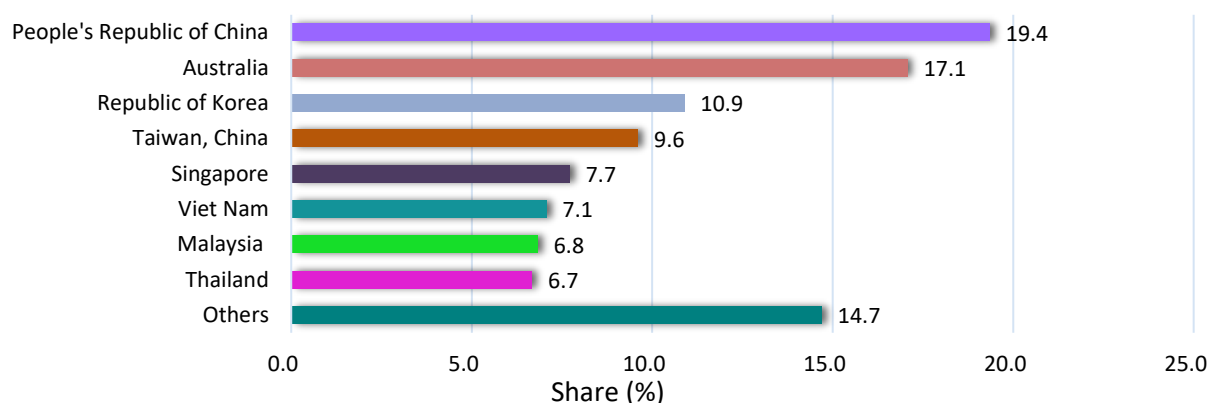
1. *The total trade for May 2025 was BND1,803.5 million, comprising exports valued at BND1,027.9 million and imports amounting to BND775.6 million.*
2. *The major contributors to the export value were Mineral Fuels accounting for 70.9 per cent, followed by Chemicals at 26.1 per cent, and Manufactured Goods at 1.0 per cent.*

3. *The main export markets were the People's Republic of China accounting for 19.4 per cent, followed by Australia and the Republic of Korea at 17.1 per cent and 10.9 per cent, respectively. The largest export commodities to these countries were Mineral Fuels and Chemicals.*

4. *Meanwhile, imports in May 2025 were valued at BND775.6 million. The three main import commodities were Mineral Fuels, accounting for 68.9 per cent, followed by Machinery and Transport Equipment at 9.7 per cent, and Food at 8.0 per cent.*

5. *The largest import partners were Malaysia, accounting for 39.6 per cent, followed by People's Republic of China at 6.8 per cent, and Australia at 4.9 per cent. The main import commodities from these trading partners were Mineral Fuels, Food, as well as Machinery and Transport Equipment.*
6. *Compared to April 2025, the total trade declined by 7.0 per cent in May 2025 due to a 11.9 per cent decrease in exports.*
7. *The imports for end use categories were mainly used as Intermediate Goods processing accounting for 58.1 per cent, followed by Capital Goods for business operations at 38.7 per cent, and Consumption Goods for household use at 3.2 per cent.*
