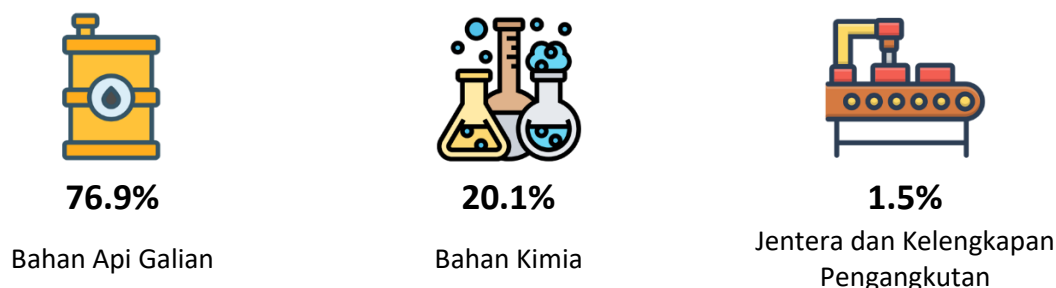

IMBANGAN PERDAGANGAN MENINGKAT 24.1 PERATUS TAHUN-KE-TAHUN

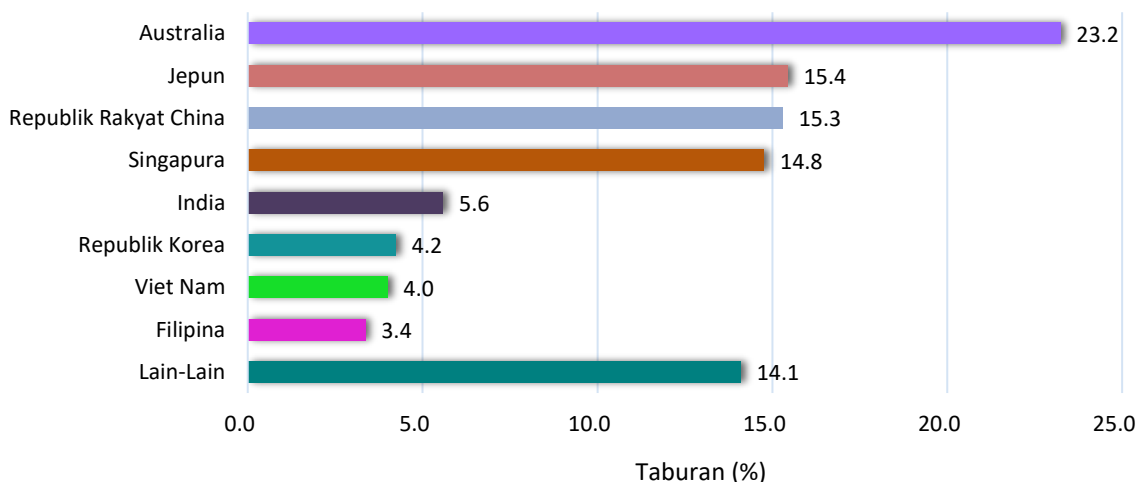
1. Imbangan perdagangan bagi bulan Oktober 2025 meningkat sebanyak 24.1 peratus, berbanding bulan Oktober 2024. Ini adalah didorong oleh peningkatan eksport sebanyak 8.3 peratus kepada BND1,147.5 juta, manakala, nilai import mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 3.0 peratus kepada BND600.2 juta.
2. Penyumbang utama kepada nilai eksport adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 76.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Bahan Kimia sebanyak 20.1 peratus, dan Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 1.5 peratus.

3. Pasaran eksport utama adalah Australia sebanyak 23.2 peratus, diikuti oleh Jepun dan Republik Rakyat China, masing-masing sebanyak 15.4 peratus dan 15.3 peratus. Komoditi eksport terbesar ke negara-negara tersebut adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Bahan Kimia.

4. Manakala, bagi import pula, penyumbang utama adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 55.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 12.4 peratus, dan Makanan sebanyak 10.3 peratus.

5. Sumbangan terbesar rakan dagangan import adalah dari Malaysia sebanyak 29.5 peratus, diikuti oleh Kazakhstan sebanyak 15.4 peratus, dan Australia sebanyak 11.0 peratus. Komoditi import utama daripada rakan dagangan adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Makanan.
6. Secara keseluruhan, jumlah perdagangan bagi bulan Oktober 2025 meningkat sebanyak 4.1 peratus kepada BND1,747.7 juta, berbanding bulan Oktober 2024.
7. Import mengikut kategori penggunaan akhir digunakan untuk pemprosesan Barangan Perantaraan sebanyak 60.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Barangan Modal bagi operasi perniagaan sebanyak 34.4 peratus, dan Barangan Penggunaan bagi kegunaan isi rumah sebanyak 4.7 peratus.
8. Berbanding September 2025, jumlah perdagangan meningkat sebanyak 3.1 peratus pada bulan Oktober 2025, didorong oleh peningkatan eksport sebanyak 12.0 peratus.

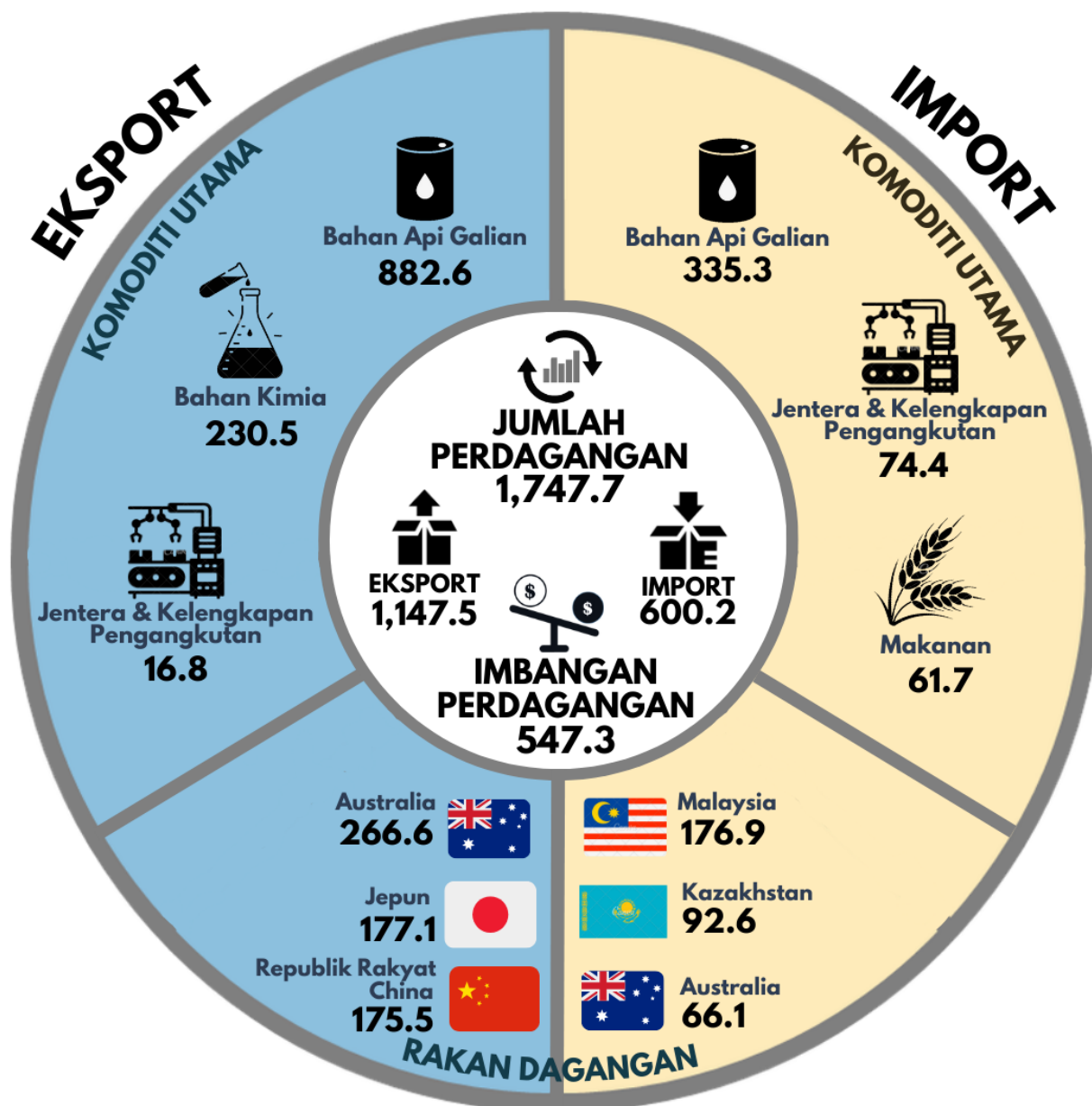

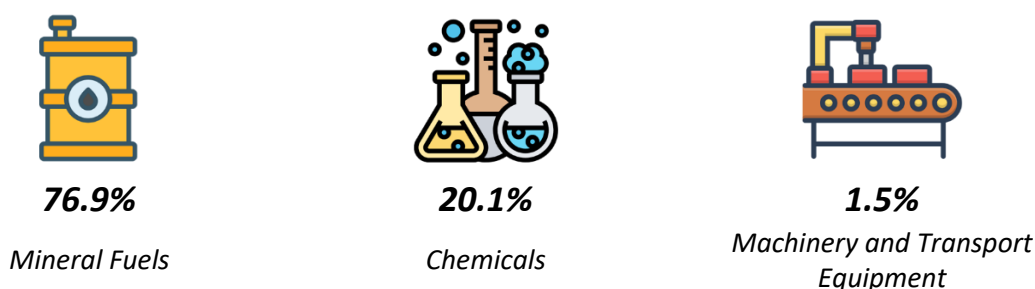

TRADE BALANCE GREW BY 24.1 PER CENT YEAR-ON-YEAR

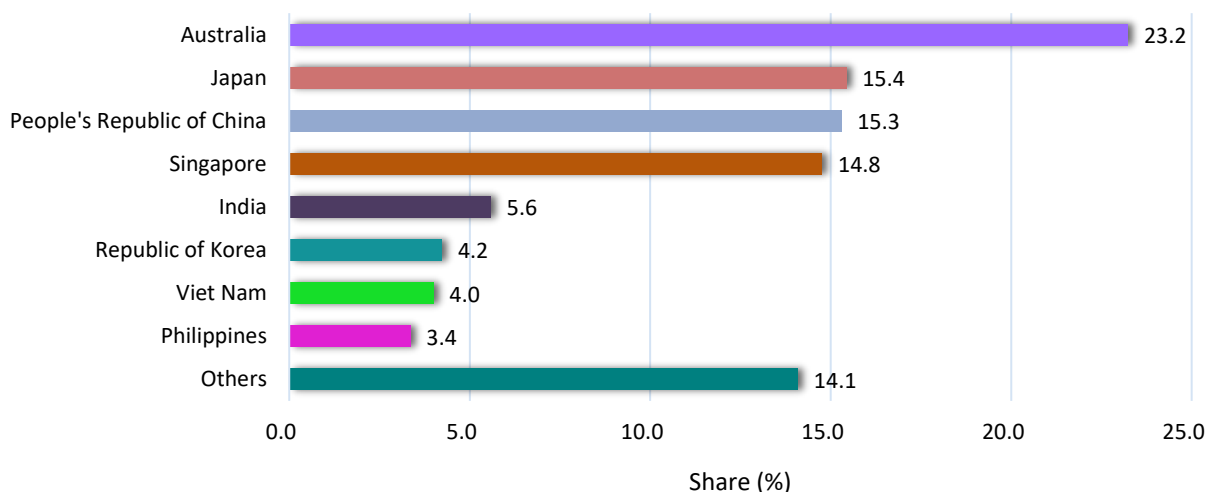
1. The trade balance in October 2025 rose by 24.1 per cent, compared to October 2024. This was driven by an 8.3 per cent increase in exports to BND1,147.5 million, while, import value recorded a decrease of 3.0 per cent to BND600.2.
2. The major contributors to the export value were Mineral Fuels accounting for 76.9 per cent, followed by Chemicals at 20.1 per cent, and Machinery and Transport Equipment at 1.5 per cent.

Main Exports by Commodity



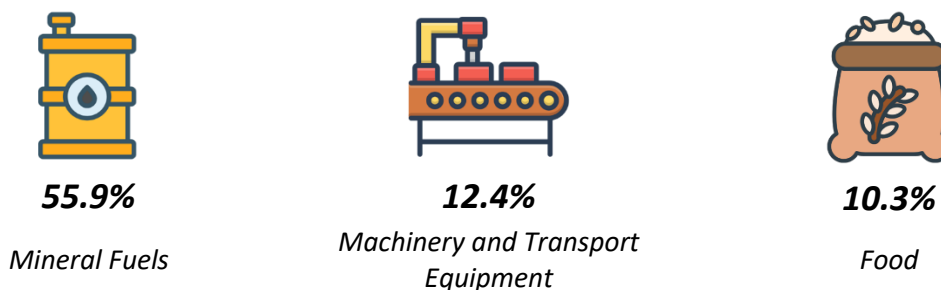
3. The main export markets were Australia accounting for 23.2 per cent, followed by Japan and People's Republic of China at 15.4 per cent and 15.3 per cent, respectively. The largest export commodities to these countries were Mineral Fuels and Chemicals.

4. Meanwhile, for imports, the major contributors were Mineral Fuels at 55.9 per cent, followed by Machinery and Transport Equipment at 12.4 per cent, and Food at 10.3 per cent.

5. The largest import partners were Malaysia, accounting for 29.5 per cent, followed by Kazakhstan at 15.4 per cent, and Australia at 11.0 per cent. The main import commodities from these trading partners were Mineral Fuels and Food.
6. Overall, the total trade for October 2025 grew by 4.1 per cent to BND1,747.7 million, compared to October 2024.
7. The imports for end use categories were mainly used as Intermediate Goods processing accounting for 60.9 per cent, followed by Capital Goods for business operations at 34.4 per cent, and Consumption Goods for household use at 4.7 per cent.
8. Compared to September 2025, the total trade increased by 3.1 per cent in October 2025, driven by an increase in exports by 12.0 per cent.
