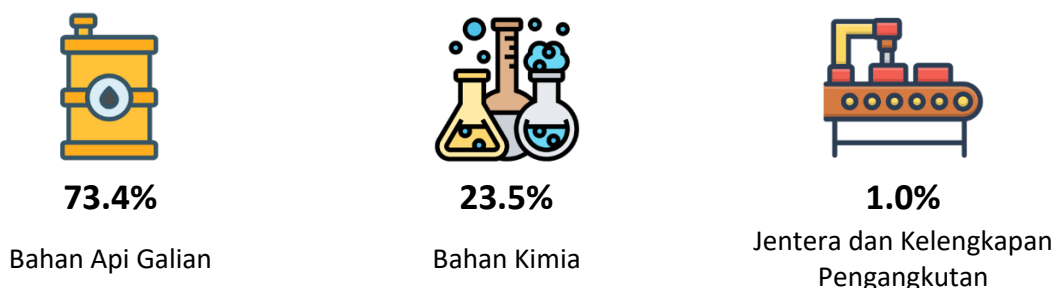

IMBANGAN PERDAGANGAN MENCATATKAN LEBIHAN SEBANYAK BND390.0 JUTA PADA
NOVEMBER 2025

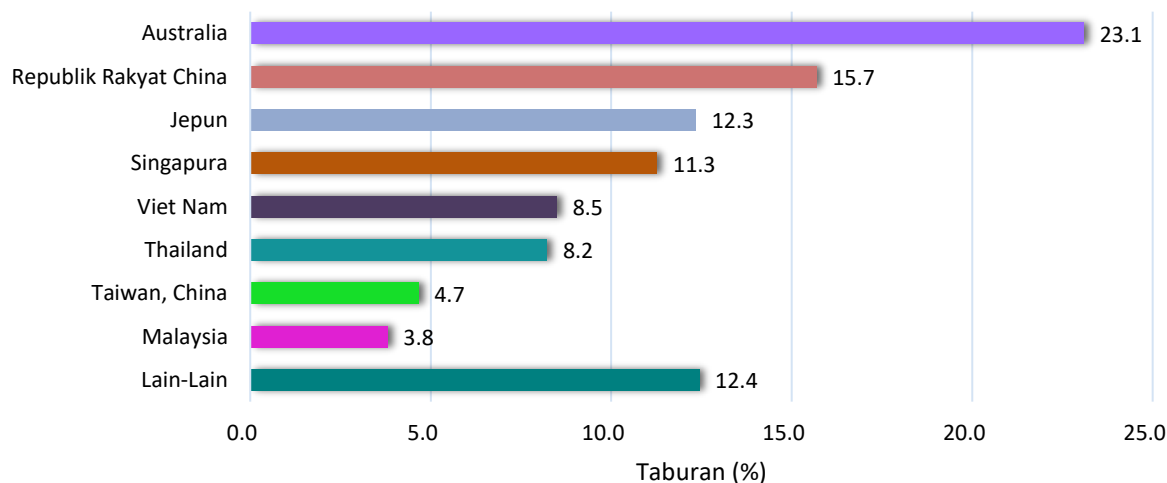
1. Jumlah perdagangan pada bulan November 2025 berjumlah BND1,687.4 juta, merangkumi eksport bernilai BND1,038.7 juta dan import berjumlah BND648.7 juta, sekaligus menghasilkan imbalan perdagangan lebih sebanyak BND390.0 juta.
2. Penyumbang utama kepada nilai eksport adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 73.4 peratus, diikuti oleh Bahan Kimia sebanyak 23.5 peratus, dan Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 1.0 peratus.

3. Pasaran eksport utama adalah Australia sebanyak 23.1 peratus, diikuti oleh Republik Rakyat China dan Jepun, masing-masing sebanyak 15.7 peratus dan 12.3 peratus. Komoditi eksport terbesar ke negara-negara tersebut adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Bahan Kimia.

4. Manakala, bagi import pula, penyumbang utama adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 65.7 peratus, diikuti oleh Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 10.7 peratus, dan Makanan sebanyak 10.1 peratus.

5. Sumbangan terbesar rakan dagangan import adalah dari Malaysia sebanyak 50.4 peratus, diikuti oleh Afrika Selatan sebanyak 13.1 peratus, dan Republik Rakyat China sebanyak 7.4 peratus. Komoditi import utama daripada rakan dagangan adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Makanan.
6. Import mengikut kategori penggunaan akhir digunakan untuk pemprosesan Barangan Perantaraan sebanyak 59.6 peratus, diikuti oleh Barangan Modal bagi operasi perniagaan sebanyak 36.4 peratus, dan Barangan Penggunaan bagi kegunaan isi rumah sebanyak 4.0 peratus.
7. Berbanding bulan November 2024, jumlah nilai perdagangan menurun sebanyak 10.1 peratus pada bulan November 2025, didorong oleh penurunan eksport dan import masing-masing sebanyak 9.9 peratus dan 10.4 peratus. Penurunan nilai eksport terutamanya didorong oleh harga global komoditi utama yang lebih rendah.

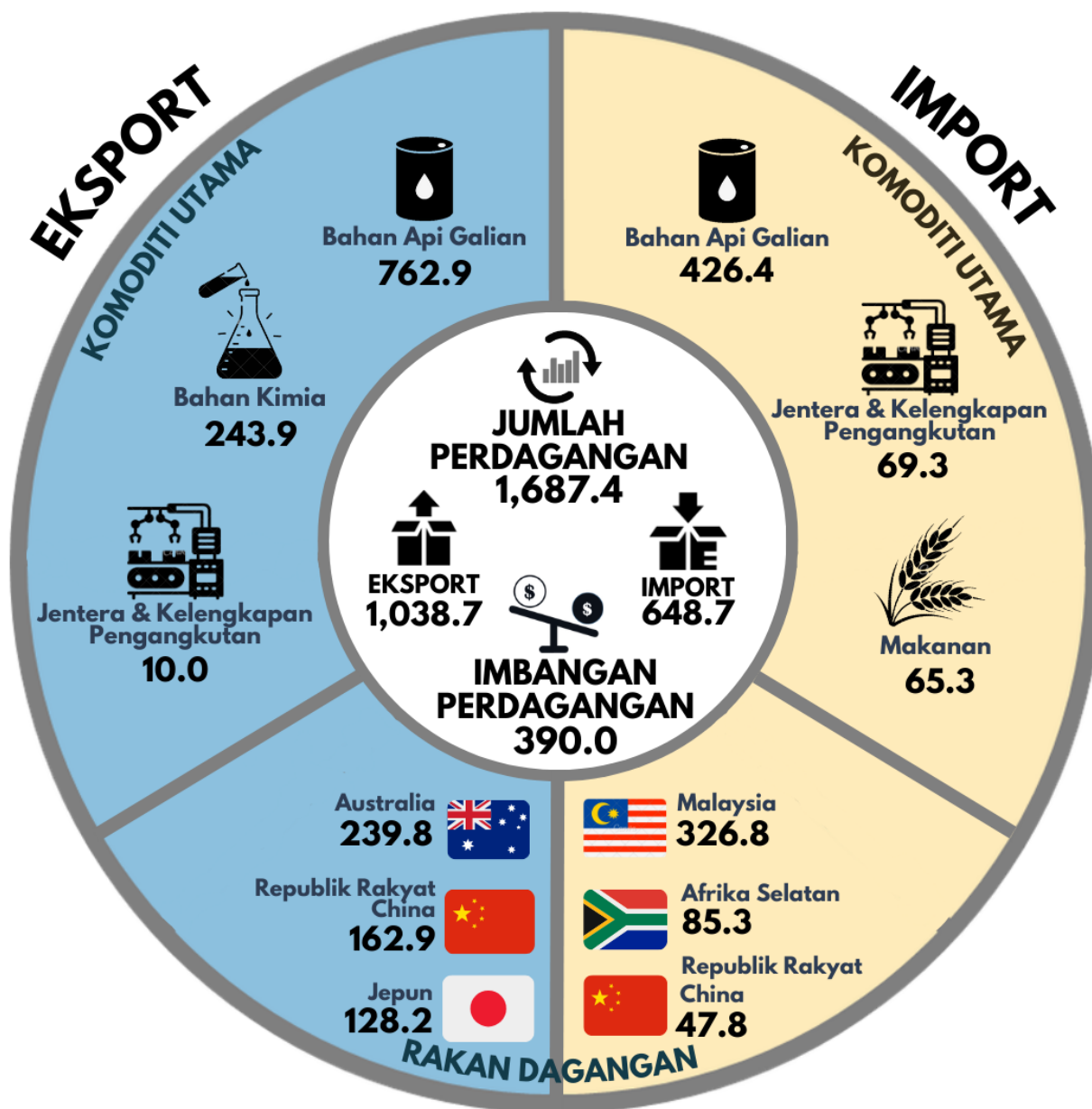

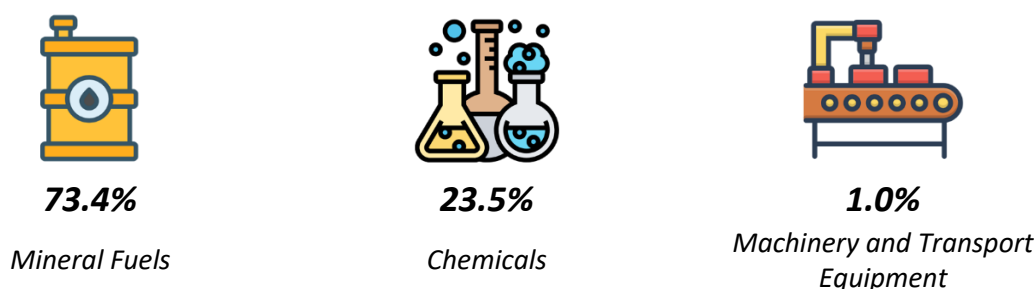

TRADE BALANCE RECORDED A SURPLUS OF BND390.0 MILLION IN NOVEMBER 2025

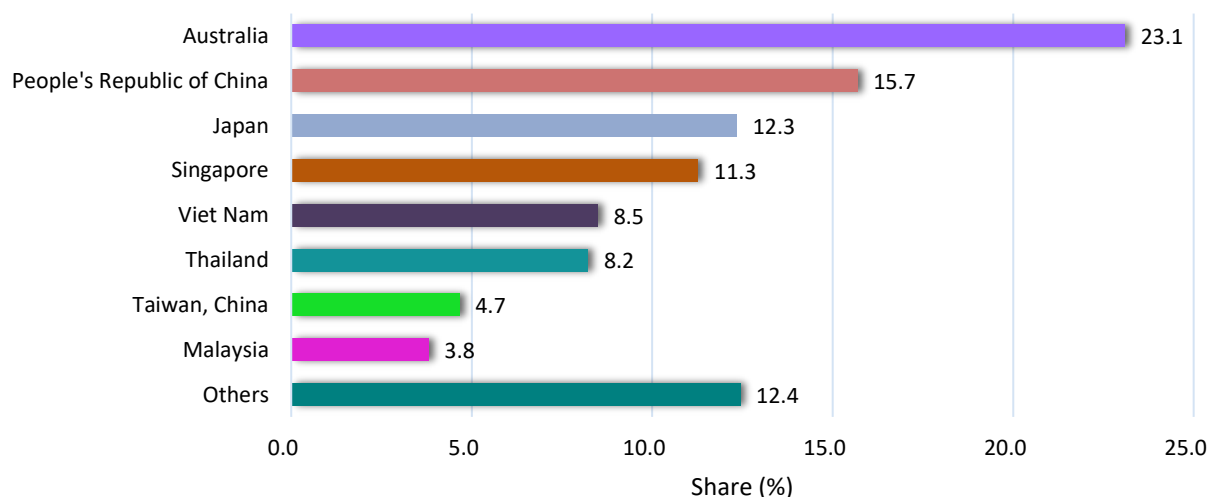
1. The total trade in November 2025 amounted to BND1,687.4 million, comprising exports valued at BND1,038.7 million and imports amounting to BND648.7 million, resulting in a trade surplus of BND390.0 million.
2. The major contributors to the export value were Mineral Fuels accounting for 73.4 per cent, followed by Chemicals at 23.5 per cent, and Machinery and Transport Equipment at 1.0 per cent.

3. The main export markets were Australia accounting for 23.1 per cent, followed by the People's Republic of China and Japan at 15.7 per cent and 12.3 per cent, respectively. The largest export commodities to these countries were Mineral Fuels and Chemicals.

4. Meanwhile, for imports, the major contributors were Mineral Fuels at 65.7 per cent, followed by Machinery and Transport Equipment at 10.7 per cent, and Food at 10.1 per cent.

5. The largest import partners were Malaysia, accounting for 50.4 per cent, followed by South Africa at 13.1 per cent, and People's Republic of China at 7.4 per cent. The main import commodities from these trading partners were Mineral Fuels and Food.
6. The imports for end use categories were mainly used as Intermediate Goods processing accounting for 59.6 per cent, followed by Capital Goods for business operations at 36.4 per cent, and Consumption Goods for household use at 4.0 per cent.
7. Compared to November 2024, the total trade value declined by 10.1 per cent in November 2025, driven by decreases in both exports and imports by 9.9 per cent and 10.4 per cent, respectively. The decline in exports value was mainly driven by lower global prices of key commodities.
