**IMBANGAN PERDAGANGAN MENCATATKAN LEBIHAN SEBANYAK BND5,056.8 JUTA BAGI
TAHUN 2025**

1. Bagi tahun 2025, jumlah perdagangan mencatatkan sebanyak BND21,880.2 juta, merangkumi eksport bernilai BND13,468.5 juta dan import berjumlah BND8,411.7 juta, menghasilkan imbalan perdagangan lebih sebanyak BND5,056.8 juta.
2. Penyumbang utama kepada nilai eksport adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 74.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Bahan Kimia sebanyak 22.2 peratus dan Barang-Barang Keluaran Kilang sebanyak 0.5 peratus. Manakala, bagi import, penyumbang utama adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 65.8 peratus, diikuti oleh Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 10.4 peratus, dan Makanan sebanyak 8.1 peratus.

3. Jumlah perdagangan pada bulan Disember 2025 berjumlah BND2,147.1 juta, merangkumi eksport bernilai BND1,142.0 juta dan import berjumlah BND1,005.1 juta, sekaligus menghasilkan imbalan perdagangan lebih sebanyak BND136.9 juta.
4. Penyumbang utama kepada nilai eksport adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 72.7 peratus, diikuti oleh Bahan Kimia sebanyak 22.2 peratus, dan Bahan-Bahan Mentah Tidak Boleh Dimakan sebanyak 0.2 peratus.



5. Pasaran eksport utama adalah Australia sebanyak 26.5 peratus, diikuti oleh Republik Rakyat China dan Singapura, masing-masing sebanyak 13.7 peratus dan 13.4 peratus. Komoditi eksport terbesar ke negara-negara tersebut adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Bahan Kimia.

6. Manakala, bagi import pula, penyumbang utama adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 65.8 peratus, diikuti oleh Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 9.7 peratus, dan Makanan sebanyak 7.3 peratus.

7. Sumbangan terbesar rakan dagangan import adalah dari Malaysia sebanyak 55.1 peratus, diikuti oleh Emiriah Arab Bersatu sebanyak 9.5 peratus, dan Kazakhstan sebanyak 9.1 peratus. Komoditi import utama daripada rakan dagangan adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Makanan.
8. Import mengikut kategori penggunaan akhir digunakan untuk pemprosesan Barangan Perantaraan sebanyak 57.2 peratus, diikuti oleh Barangan Modal bagi operasi perniagaan sebanyak 39.3 peratus, dan Barangan Penggunaan bagi kegunaan isi rumah sebanyak 3.5 peratus.





TRADE BALANCE RECORDED A SURPLUS OF BND5,056.8 MILLION IN 2025

1. In 2025, total trade recorded a total of BND21,880.2 million, comprising exports valued at BND13,468.5 million and imports amounting to BND8,411.7 million, resulting in a trade balance surplus of BND5,056.8 million.
2. The major contributors to the exports value were Mineral Fuels accounting for 74.9 per cent, followed by Chemicals at 22.2 per cent, and Manufactured Goods at 0.5 per cent. Meanwhile, for imports, the major contributors were Mineral Fuels at 65.8 per cent, followed by Machinery and Transport Equipment at 10.4 per cent, and Food at 8.1 per cent.

Comparison of December 2025 with December 2024

3. The total trade in December 2025 amounted to BND2,147.1 million, comprising exports valued at BND1,142.0 million and imports valued at BND1,005.1 million, resulting in a trade balance surplus of BND136.9 million.
4. The major contributors to the exports value were Mineral Fuels accounting for 72.7 per cent, followed by Chemicals at 22.2 per cent, and Crude Materials, Inedible at 0.2 per cent.




5. The main export markets were Australia accounting for 26.5 per cent, followed by the People's Republic of China and Singapore at 13.7 per cent and 13.4 per cent, respectively. The largest export commodities to these countries were Mineral Fuels and Chemicals.

6. *Meanwhile, for imports, the major contributors were Mineral Fuels at 65.8 per cent, followed by Machinery and Transport Equipment at 9.7 per cent, and Food at 7.3 per cent.*

7. *The largest import partners were Malaysia, accounting for 55.1 per cent, followed by United Arab Emirates at 9.5 per cent, and Kazakhstan at 9.1 per cent. The main import commodities from these trading partners were Mineral Fuels and Food.*
8. *The imports for end use categories were mainly used as Intermediate Goods processing accounting for 57.2 per cent, followed by Capital Goods for business operations at 39.3 per cent, and Consumption Goods for household use at 3.5 per cent.*


