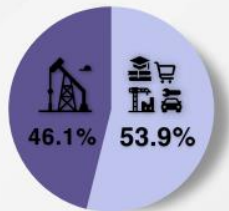

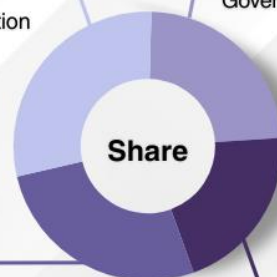

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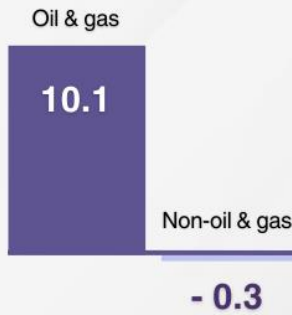

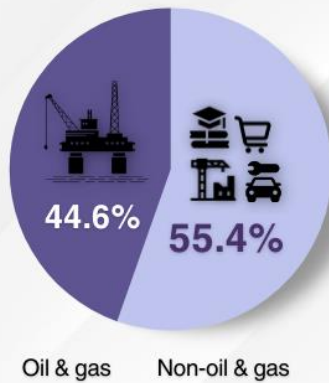

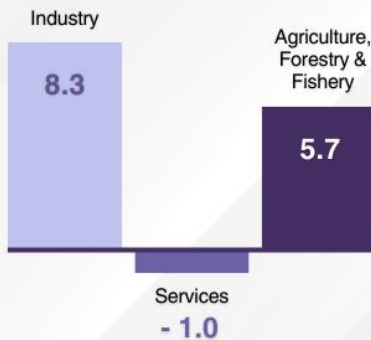


NON-OIL & GAS SECTOR KEY CONTRIBUTORS

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## Highlights

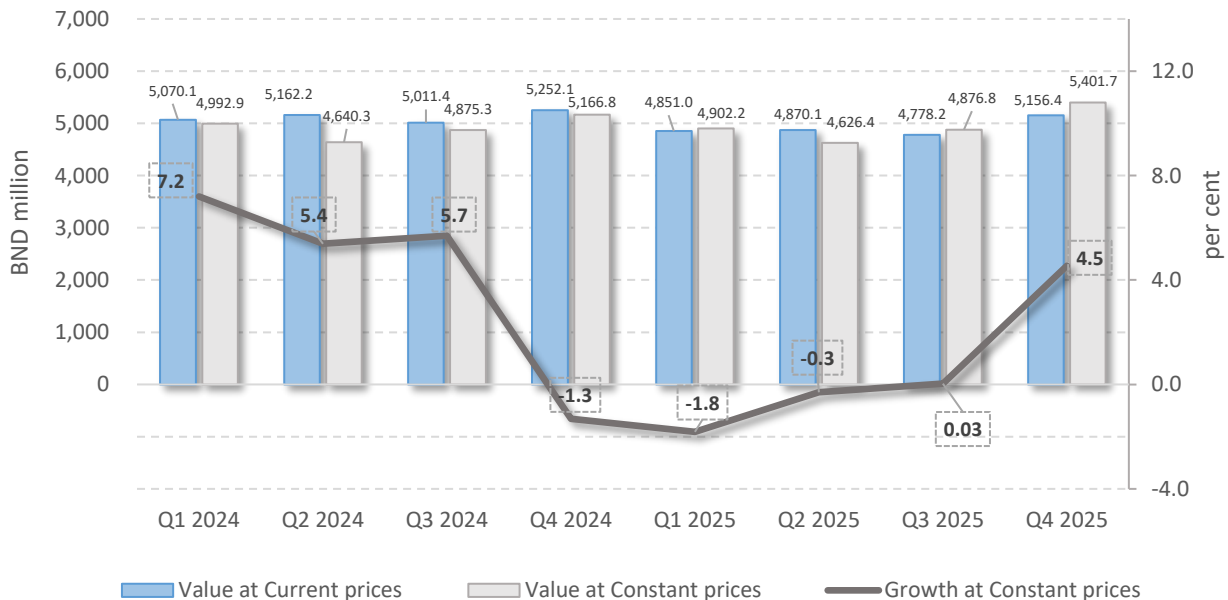
In the fourth quarter of 2025 (Q4 2025), Brunei Darussalam’s Gross Domestic Product (GDP) posted a positive growth of 4.5 per cent year-on-year at constant prices (measured at 2010 base year prices) (Table 1 and Chart 1).

GDP at current prices (measured at prevailing prices during the period) was estimated at BND5.2 billion in Q4 2025, compared to BND5.3 billion in Q4 2024.

## Annual GDP 2025

Brunei Darussalam's economy in 2025 expanded by 0.7 per cent which was attributed to an increase in Oil & Gas sector by 3.1 per cent. The growth in the Oil & Gas sector was due to the increase in the activities of Oil and gas mining and Manufacture of Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG). Meanwhile, the Non-Oil & Gas sector recorded a decrease of 1.5 per cent.

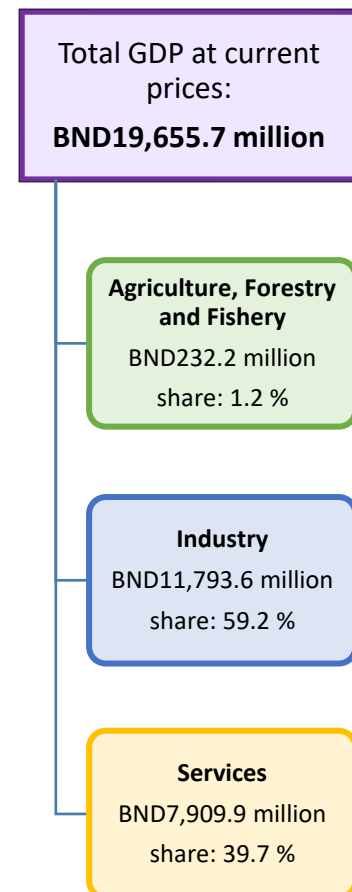
At current prices, the annual GDP in 2025 was valued at BND19,655.7 million.

The Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery sector in 2025 has increased by 0.1 per cent due to the increase in the subsectors of Fishery by 5.4 per cent and Livestock and poultry 2.6 per cent. Meanwhile, Forestry has decreased by 20.5 per cent and Vegetables, fruits & other agriculture 14.3 per cent. This sector at current prices has contributed to about BND232.2 million or 1.2 per cent of the total GVA in 2025.

The Industry sector has shown a positive growth of 1.9 per cent due to the increase in the subsectors of Oil and gas mining by 3.5 per cent, followed by Manufacture of food and beverage products 0.9 per cent and Manufacture of LNG and other petroleum & chemical products 0.5 per cent. Meanwhile, negative growths were shown in the subsectors of Other manufacturing by 17.5 per cent, Manufacture of wearing apparel & textiles 8.1 per cent, Electricity and water 4.4 per cent and Construction 2.2 per cent. In 2025, this sector was valued at BND11,793.6 million at current prices and contributed to around 59.2 per cent of the total GVA.

The Services sector has declined by 1.1 per cent due to the decrease in the subsectors of Health services by 7.1 per cent, Finance 5.5 per cent, Business services 4.9 per cent, Land transport 2.3 per cent, Wholesale and retail trade 2.1 per cent, Other private services 1.0 per cent, Hotels 0.81 per cent, Restaurants 0.78 per cent, Other transport services 0.6 per cent and Government Services/Public Administration 0.03 per cent. Meanwhile, positive growths were shown in the subsectors of Air transport by 16.4 per cent, Water transport 3.2 per cent, Education services 2.9 per cent, Real estate & ownership of dwellings 2.4 per cent, Domestic services 2.0 per cent and Communication 1.2 per cent. At current prices, this sector was valued at BND7,909.9 million and amounted to 39.7 per cent of the total GVA in 2025.

In terms of GDP by Expenditure, negative growths were recorded in Imports of goods and services by 13.8 per cent, Gross Capital Formation 6.0 per cent, Exports of goods and services 4.1 per cent, Household Final Consumption Expenditure (HFCE) 1.8 per cent and Government Final Consumption Expenditure (GFCE) 0.8 per cent.



## GDP by Production

### A. Oil & Gas and Non-Oil & Gas sector

In Q4 2025, the Oil & Gas sector, which includes Oil and gas mining and Manufacture of LNG, increased by 10.1 per cent at constant prices year-on-year. The positive growth was due to the increase in the activities of Oil and gas mining and Manufacture of LNG (Table 2).

The production of LNG has increased from 678.1 thousand Million British Thermal Unit per day (MMBtu/d) in Q4 2024 to 776.7 thousand MMBtu/d in Q4 2025. Meanwhile, production of crude oil also showed similar trend where production was from 104.9 thousand barrel per day in Q4 2024 to 114.5 thousand barrel per day in Q4 2025. Natural gas production has also increased to 29.4 million cubic metre per day in Q4 2025 from 26.7 million cubic metre per day in Q4 2024.

At current prices, the GVA of this sector was estimated at BND2,327.5 million in Q4 2025 compared to BND2,371.8 million in Q4 2024.

This sector's contribution to the total Gross Value Added (GVA) in Q4 2025 was about 44.6 per cent. The average oil price in Q4 2025 has declined by 12.8 per cent from USD77.24 per barrel (USD/barrel) in Q4 2024 to USD67.38 per barrel in Q4 2025. LNG price has also dropped by 14.0 per cent from USD9.75 per Million British Thermal Unit (USD/MMBtu) in Q4 2024 to USD8.39 per MMBtu in Q4 2025.

Meanwhile, the Non-Oil & Gas sector decreased by 0.3 per cent in Q4 2025.

Downstream activities which include new production of petroleum and chemical products contributed a total GVA of BND447.0 million and Other non-oil & gas activities contributed a total GVA of BND2,350.9 million at constant prices.

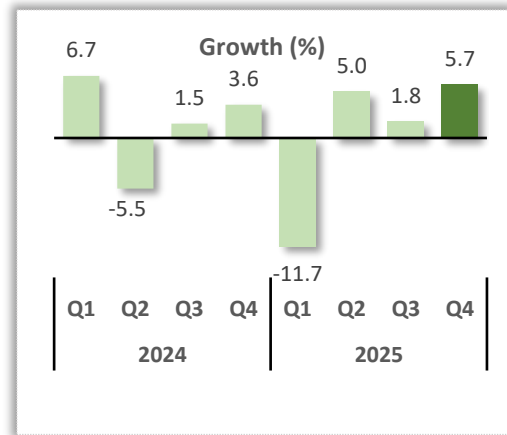

**B. By Kind of Economic Activity**

**The Agriculture, Forestry & Fishery sector**

In Q4 2025, this sector increased by 5.7 per cent due to the increase in Fishery by 10.1 per cent, Vegetables, fruits & other agriculture 4.5 per cent, Livestock and poultry 3.0 per cent and Forestry 2.1 per cent.

At current prices, the Agriculture, Forestry & Fishery sector was valued at BND52.3 million in Q4 2025, accounting for about 1.0 per cent to the total GVA (Table 3).

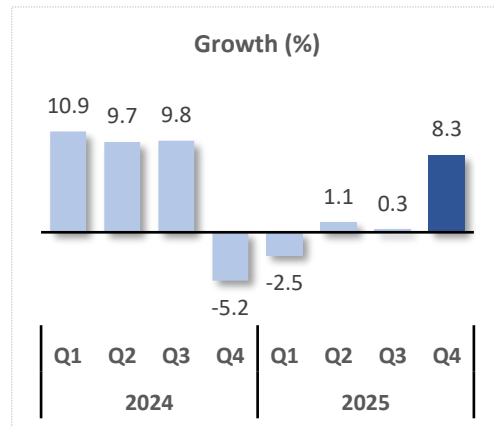

**The Industrial Sector**

The Industrial sector has increased by 8.3 per cent in Q4 2025. This was mainly attributed to the increase in Manufacture of LNG and other petroleum & chemical products by 10.1 per cent and Oil and gas mining 9.0 per cent.

Meanwhile, Other manufacturing decreased by 17.6 per cent, Manufacture of wearing apparel & textiles 12.0 per cent, Construction 2.2 per cent, Manufacture of food and beverage products 1.8 per cent and Electricity and water 0.7 per cent.

At current prices, this sector was valued at BND2,968.0 million, contributing 56.9 per cent to the total GVA (Table 4).

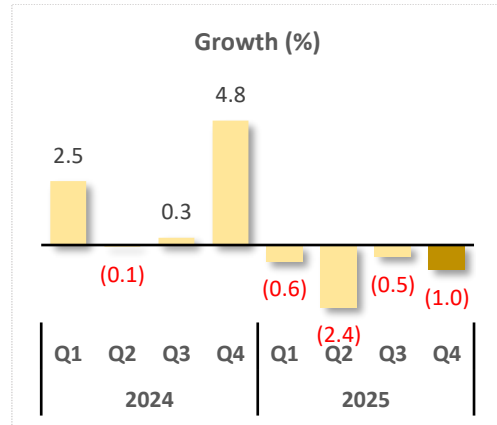

**The Services Sector**

The services sector has decreased in this quarter by 1.0 per cent. The negative growths were recorded in Finance by 8.1 per cent, followed by Business services 6.6 per cent, Hotels 4.4 per cent, Other transport services 3.3 per cent, Wholesale and retail trade 3.0 per cent, Health services 1.6 per cent, Restaurants 1.1 per cent and Water transport 0.9 per cent.

Meanwhile, Air transport were increased by 13.1 per cent, Education services 6.6 per cent, Real estate & ownership of dwellings 2.4 per cent, Communication 2.1 per cent, Domestic services 2.0 per cent, Other private services 1.9 per cent, Land transport 1.6 per cent and Government Services/Public Administration 0.8 per cent.

At current prices, the services sector was valued at BND 2,198.4 million and contributed 42.1 per cent to the total GVA in Q4 2025 (Table 5).

## GDP by Expenditure

The Government Final Consumption Expenditure (GFCE) has decreased by 9.2 per cent at constant prices. GFCE at current prices was valued at BND1,198.9 million and contributed 23.3 per cent to the total GDP (Appendix 3 & 4).

Household Final Consumption Expenditure (HFCE) continued to increase by 4.4 per cent at constant prices. With a total value of BND1,620.5 million at current prices, HFCE contributed 31.4 per cent to the total GDP.

Gross Capital Formation (GCF) posted a negative growth of 1.4 per cent at constant prices in Q4 2025. This was due to the decrease in Gross Fixed Capital Formation (GFCF) by 1.4 per cent. At current prices, GCF was estimated at BND1,196.8 million, contributing 23.2 per cent to the total GDP (Table 6).

Exports of goods and services has recorded an increase of 7.1 per cent due to the increase in both Exports of goods by 6.7 per cent and Exports of services by 17.1 per cent. Meanwhile, Imports of

goods and services has decreased by 3.1 per cent due to the decrease in both Imports of goods by 1.5 per cent and Imports of services by 8.2 per cent.

**Notes:**

- 1) The new GDP series with 2010 as the base year has been released to replace the 2000-based series.
- 2) The quarterly GDP is compiled by both the production and expenditure approaches at current (nominal) and constant (real) prices. GDP at current prices refers to GDP measured at the prevailing prices in the current accounting period. GDP at constant prices is measured at given prices of 2010-base year to enable a meaningful comparison to see the changes in the level or volume of economic activities over time.
- 3) Under the production approach, GDP is the sum of the value-added of the various industries in the economy plus taxes on products minus subsidies on products. Gross Value Added (GVA) is calculated for every economic activity and then summed up to obtain the total GVA at basic prices for the whole economy. GVA cannot be measured at purchasers' prices, as GVA is from the producers' perspective. At the same time, GDP cannot be measured at basic prices, it is always at purchasers' prices, as GDP is an expenditure concept and expenditures are incurred only at purchasers' or market prices. In order to bring the GVA to GDP, the relevant taxes and subsidies need to be included on the total GVA.

$$\text{GDP} = \sum \text{GVA at basic prices} + \text{Taxes on Production} - \text{Subsidies on Products}$$

- 4) GDP by expenditure is the sum of household final consumption expenditure (HFCE), government final consumption expenditure (GFCE), capital formation or investment (I) and exports (X) less imports (M) of goods and services.

$$\text{GDP} = \text{HFCE} + \text{GFCE} + \text{I} + \text{X} - \text{M}$$

- 5) A statistical discrepancy (SD) is added to the GDP by expenditure to record the difference between the GDP values obtained from the production and expenditure approaches, since GDP from production approach is treated as the firmer estimate of GDP.
- 6) The quarterly GDP series is not seasonally-adjusted and all growth rates are computed on a year-on-year basis, i.e. the current quarter compared to the same quarter in the previous year.
- 7) Starting from quarter four (Q4) 2019 in Appendix 1 & 2, the 'Manufacture of liquefied natural gas and methanol' in Industrial sector has been renamed to 'Manufacture of liquefied natural gas and other petroleum and chemical products' to include the new production of petroleum and chemical products from the downstream activities.
- 8) Starting from quarter four (Q4) 2019, Appendix 1 & 2 will include the Oil and Gas sector which comprises of Oil & gas mining and Manufacture of LNG; and the Non-Oil and Gas sector which comprises of downstream activities including production of methanol, other petroleum and chemical products and other activities.
