IMBANGAN PERDAGANGAN MENCATATKAN LEBIHAN BND467.9 JUTA BAGI JANUARI 2026

1. Jumlah perdagangan pada bulan Januari 2026 adalah sebanyak BND1,824.1 juta, yang terdiri daripada eksport bernilai BND1,146.0 juta dan import berjumlah BND678.1 juta, seterusnya mencatatkan imbalan perdagangan lebih sebanyak BND467.9 juta.
2. Penyumbang utama kepada nilai eksport adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 75.5 peratus, diikuti oleh Bahan Kimia sebanyak 21.8 peratus, dan Bahan-Bahan Mentah Tidak Boleh Dimakan sebanyak 0.4 peratus.



3. Pasaran eksport utama adalah Australia sebanyak 30.2 peratus, diikuti oleh Republik Rakyat China dan Jepun, masing-masing sebanyak 22.8 peratus dan 12.2 peratus. Komoditi eksport terbesar ke negara-negara tersebut adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Bahan Kimia.

- Manakala, bagi import, penyumbang utama adalah Bahan Api Galian sebanyak 59.3 peratus, diikuti oleh Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan sebanyak 13.0 peratus, dan Makanan sebanyak 11.3 peratus.

- Sumbangan terbesar rakan dagangan import adalah dari Singapura sebanyak 33.4 peratus, diikuti oleh Emiriah Arab Bersatu sebanyak 16.3 peratus, dan Malaysia sebanyak 13.9 peratus. Komoditi import utama daripada rakan dagangan adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Makanan.
- Import mengikut kategori penggunaan akhir digunakan untuk pemrosesan Barangan Perantaraan sebanyak 59.7 peratus, diikuti oleh Barangan Modal bagi operasi perniagaan sebanyak 35.8 peratus, dan Barangan Penggunaan bagi kegunaan isi rumah sebanyak 4.5 peratus.
- Berbanding bulan Januari 2025, jumlah perdagangan menurun sebanyak 6.1 peratus pada bulan Januari 2026, didorong oleh penurunan eksport dan import masing-masing sebanyak 6.8 peratus dan 4.8 peratus.





TRADE BALANCE RECORDED A SURPLUS OF BND467.9 MILLION IN JANUARY 2026


1. The total trade in January 2026 amounted to BND1,824.1 million, comprising exports valued at BND1,146.0 million and imports valued at BND678.1 million, which recorded in a trade balance surplus of BND467.9 million.
2. The major contributors to the exports value were Mineral Fuels accounting for 75.5 per cent, followed by Chemicals at 21.8 per cent, and Crude Materials, Inedible at 0.4 per cent.

Main Exports by Commodity




3. The main export markets were Australia accounting for 30.2 per cent, followed by the People's Republic of China and Japan at 22.8 per cent and 12.2 per cent, respectively. The largest export commodities to these countries were Mineral Fuels and Chemicals.

4. *Meanwhile, for imports, the major contributors were Mineral Fuels at 59.3 per cent, followed by Machinery and Transport Equipment at 13.0 per cent, and Food at 11.3 per cent.*

5. *The largest import partners were Singapore, accounting for 33.4 per cent, followed by United Arab Emirates at 16.3 per cent, and Malaysia at 13.9 per cent. The main import commodities from these trading partners were Mineral Fuels and Food.*
6. *The imports for end use categories were mainly used as Intermediate Goods processing accounting for 59.7 per cent, followed by Capital Goods for business operations at 35.8 per cent, and Consumption Goods for household use at 4.5 per cent.*
7. *Compared to January 2025, the total trade value declined by 6.1 per cent in January 2026, driven by decreases in both exports and imports by 6.8 per cent and 4.8 per cent, respectively.*
