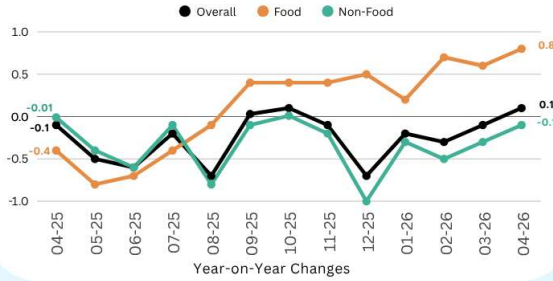

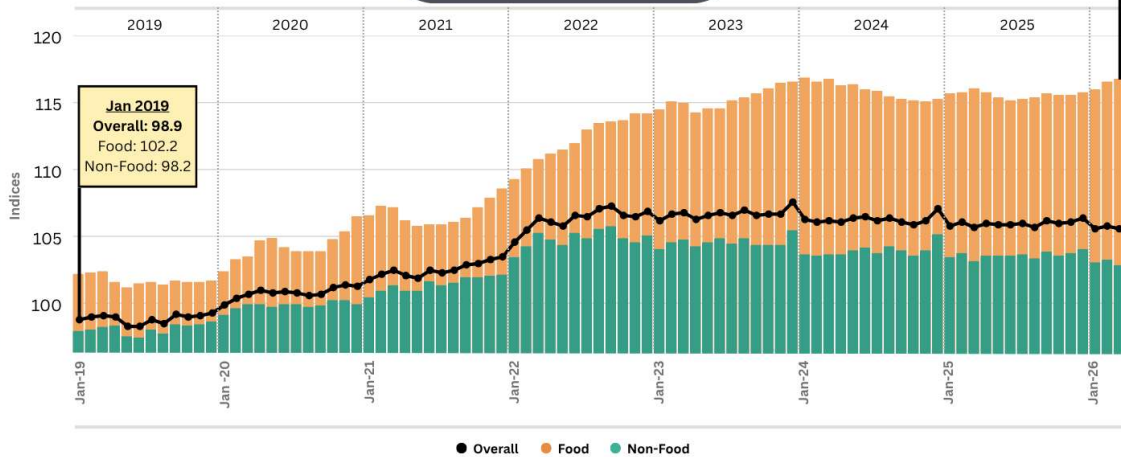

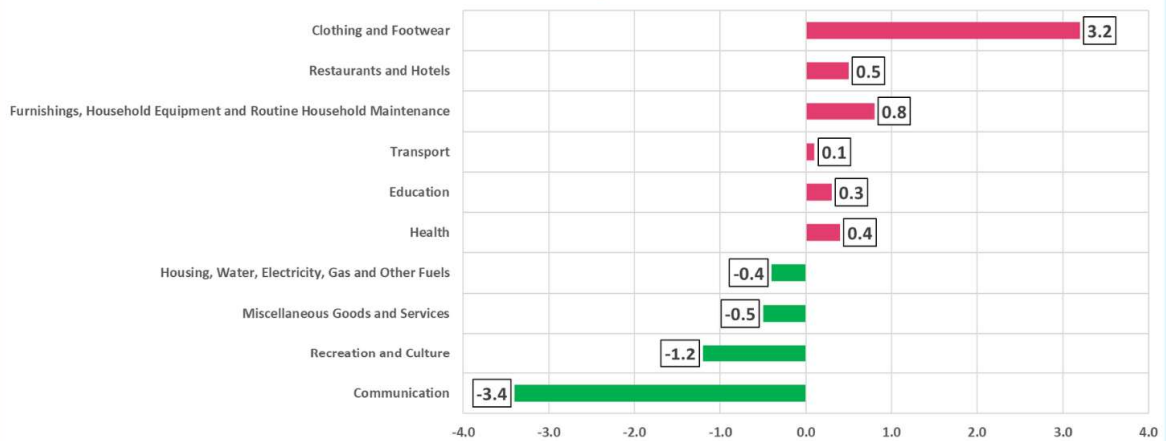

HIGHLIGHTS

In April 2026, the overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) has **increased** by 0.1 per cent year-on-year, from 106.1 in April 2025 to 106.2. This was contributed by an increase of 0.8 per cent in the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages index, while the Non-Food index registered a decrease of 0.1 per cent. Meanwhile, the Goods index increased by 0.6 per cent, while the Services index decreased by 0.6 per cent.

Compared to March 2026, the CPI has **increased** by 0.5 per cent on a month-on-month basis, contributed by an increase of 0.7 per cent in the Non-Food index. Meanwhile, the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages index decreased by 0.1 per cent.

Periodically, the CPI for January to April 2026 recorded a decrease of 0.1 per cent compared to the same period in 2025 (**Table 1**).

YEAR-ON-YEAR CHANGES (APRIL 2026 COMPARED TO APRIL 2025)

The CPI in April 2026 has increased by 0.1 per cent compared to the same month in 2025.

Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages have contributed 161.7 per cent to the overall year-on-year increase of the CPI in April 2026, followed by Clothing and Footwear 117.8 per cent; and Restaurant and Hotels 56.7 per cent (**Figure 1, Table 2**).

Price increases were recorded in:

- **Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages** 0.8 per cent due to meat; fish and seafood; and coffee, tea, and cocoa (**Table 3**);
- **Clothing and Footwear** 3.2 per cent due to clothing materials; shoes and other footwear; and garments; and
- **Restaurants and Hotels** 0.5 per cent due to restaurants, cafes, fast-food outlets and others; and accommodation services.

Price decreases were recorded in:

- **Communication** 3.4 per cent due to telephone and telefax services; and telephone and telefax equipment;
- **Recreation and Culture** 1.2 per cent due to cultural services; pets and related products; and recreational and sporting services; and
- **Miscellaneous Goods and Services** 0.5 per cent due to insurance; and other appliances articles and products for personal care.

Figure 1: CPI Year-on-Year Changes, April 2026

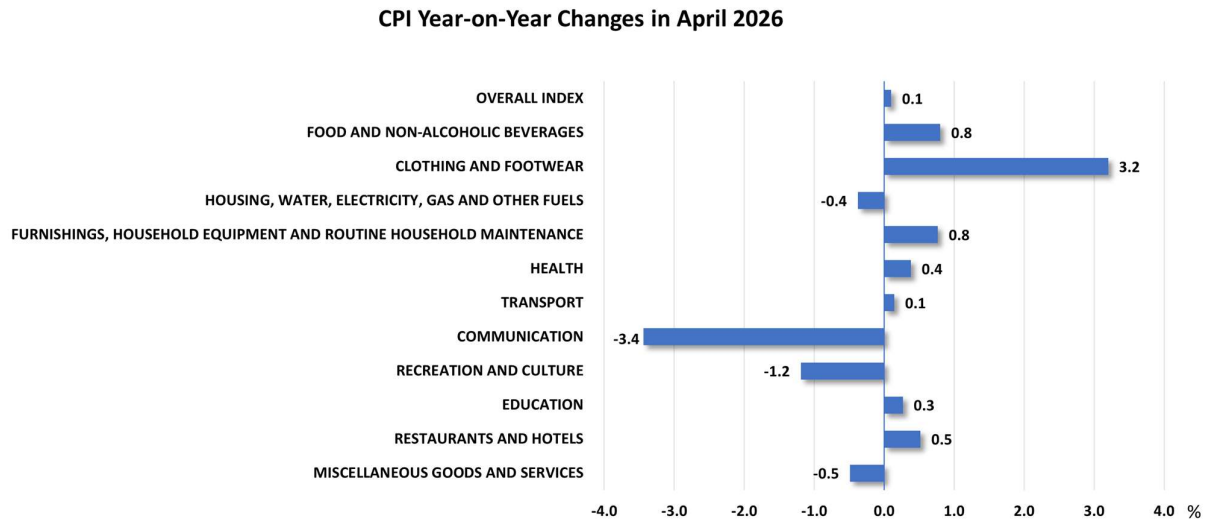

MONTH-ON-MONTH CHANGES (APRIL 2026 COMPARED TO MARCH 2026)

The CPI in April 2026 has increased by 0.5 per cent from March 2026.

Clothing and Footwear has contributed 67.1 per cent to the overall month-on-month increase of the CPI in April 2026, followed by Transport 26.7 per cent; and Recreation and Culture 6.8 per cent (**Figure 2, Table 4**).

Price increases were recorded in:

- **Clothing and Footwear** 9.8 per cent due to clothing materials; garments; and shoes and other footwear;
- **Transport** 0.7 per cent due to passenger transport by air; and
- **Recreation and Culture** 0.5 per cent due to package holidays/pilgrimages; games, toys and hobbies; and information processing equipment.

Price decreases were recorded in:

- **Miscellaneous Goods and Services** 0.3 per cent due to other appliances articles and products for personal care; and jewellery, clocks and watches; and
- **Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages** 0.1 per cent due to vegetables; fish and seafood; and oil and fats (**Table 5**).

Meanwhile, Education and Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels indices remained unchanged.

Figure 2: CPI Month-on-Month Changes, April 2026

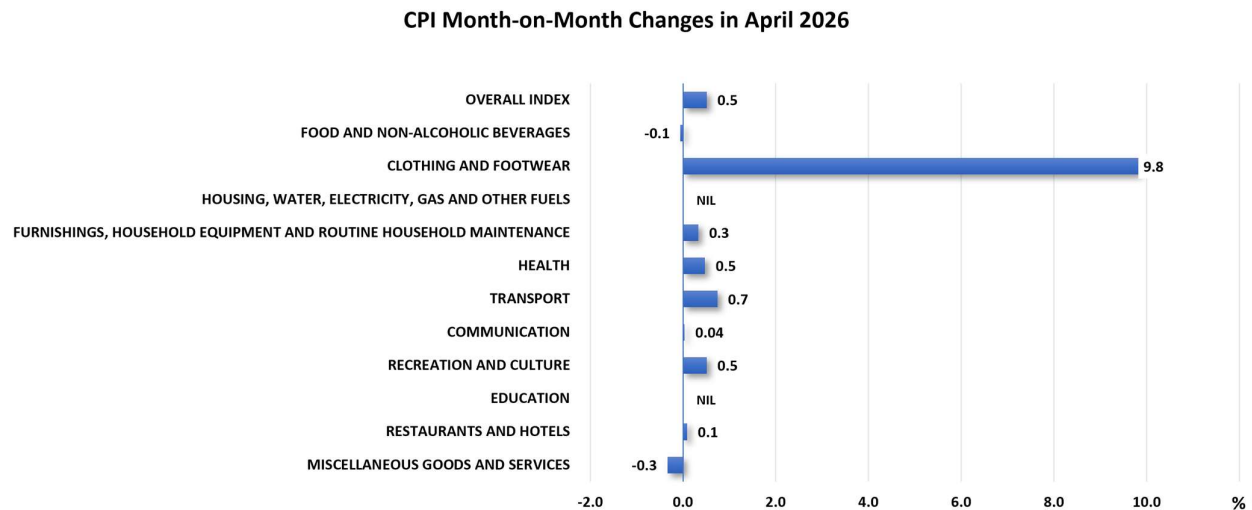

PERIOD-ON-PERIOD CHANGES (JANUARY - APRIL 2026 COMPARED TO JANUARY - APRIL 2025)

The average CPI from January to April 2026 has decreased by 0.1 per cent year-on-year compared to the same period in 2025.

Communication has contributed 145.1 per cent to the overall period-on-period decrease of the CPI from January to April 2026. This was followed by Recreation and Culture 110.7 per cent; and Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels 27.1 per cent (**Table 6**).

Price decreases were recorded in:

- **Communication** 3.5 per cent due to telephone and telefax services; and telephone and telefax equipment;
- **Recreation and Culture** 2.1 per cent due to cultural services; package holidays/pilgrimages; and pets and related products; and
- **Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels** 0.3 per cent due to services for the maintenance and repair of the dwelling; and rentals for housing.

Price increases were recorded in:

- **Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages** 0.6 per cent due to fish and seafood; meat; and fruits;
- **Restaurants and Hotels** 0.5 per cent due to restaurants, cafes, fast-food outlets and others; and accommodation services; and
- **Clothing and Footwear** 1.3 per cent due to garments; shoes and other footwear; and clothing materials.

GOODS ACCORDING TO DURABILITY AND SERVICES

For April 2026, the Goods index increased by 0.6 per cent, while the Services index recorded a decrease of 0.6 per cent. The increase in Goods was contributed by durable, semi-durable and non-durable goods.

Meanwhile, compared to March 2026, the Goods index and the Services index increased by 0.6 per cent and 0.4 per cent respectively.

For the period from January to April 2026, the Goods index registered an increase of 0.3 per cent, while the Services index decreased by 0.7 per cent, compared to the same period in 2025 (**Table 7**).
