Lebih Imbangan Perdagangan Meningkat pada Jun 2026

1. Imbangan perdagangan mencatatkan lebih BND622.6 juta iaitu meningkat sebanyak 112.8 peratus, berbanding bulan Jun 2025. Peningkatan ini didorong terutamanya oleh peningkatan eksport sebanyak 66.7 peratus. Jumlah import juga mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 46.2 peratus.
2. Kedua-dua eksport dan import menyumbang kepada prestasi perdagangan yang kukuh, dengan jumlah perdagangan meningkat sebanyak 58.3 peratus kepada BND2,537.4 juta. Jumlah eksport sebanyak BND1,580.0 juta, terutamanya disumbangkan oleh Bahan Api Galian; Bahan Kimia; dan Bahan-Bahan Mentah Yang Tidak Boleh Dimakan.

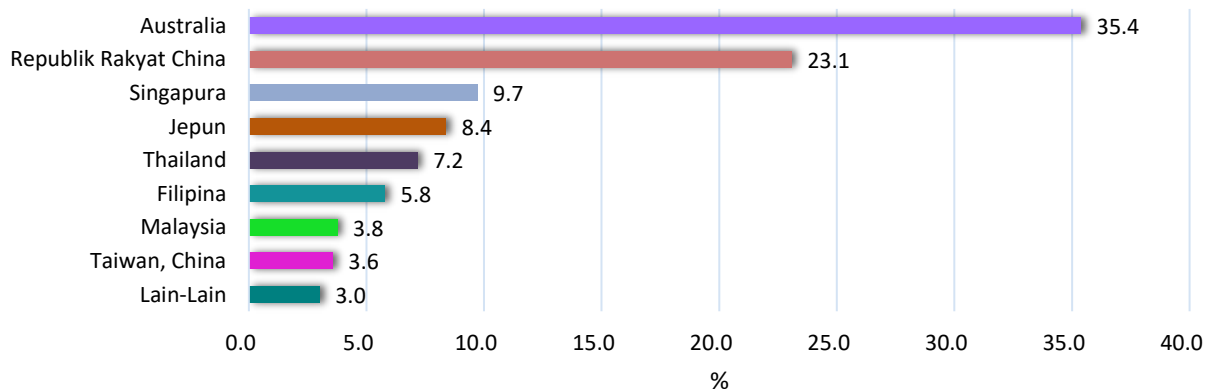

3. Pasaran eksport utama adalah Australia sebanyak 35.4 peratus, diikuti oleh Republik Rakyat China dan Singapura, masing-masing sebanyak 23.1 peratus dan 9.7 peratus. Komoditi eksport terbesar ke negara-negara tersebut adalah Bahan Api Galian.

4. Manakala, jumlah nilai import adalah sebanyak BND957.4 juta, terutamanya disumbangkan oleh Bahan Api Galian; Jentera dan kelengkapan Pengangkutan; dan Makanan.

Import Utama Mengikut Komoditi



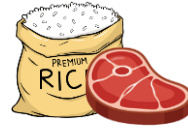

5. Sumbangan terbesar rakan dagangan import adalah dari Malaysia sebanyak 54.3 peratus, diikuti oleh Australia sebanyak 11.0 peratus, dan Republik Rakyat China sebanyak 6.6 peratus. Komoditi import utama daripada rakan dagangan adalah Bahan Api Galian dan Jentera dan Kelengkapan Pengangkutan, terutamanya helikopter.
6. Import mengikut kategori penggunaan akhir digunakan untuk pemprosesan Barangan Perantaraan sebanyak 57.1 peratus, diikuti oleh Barangan Modal bagi operasi perniagaan sebanyak 39.2 peratus, dan Barangan Penggunaan bagi kegunaan isi rumah sebanyak 3.7 peratus.
7. Berbanding bulan Mei 2026, lebih imbalan perdagangan meningkat sebanyak 36.2 peratus, terutamanya didorong oleh peningkatan jumlah eksport sebanyak 0.4 peratus, manakala, jumlah import mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 14.3 peratus. Perkembangan ini turut menyebabkan penurunan jumlah perdagangan sebanyak 5.7 peratus.

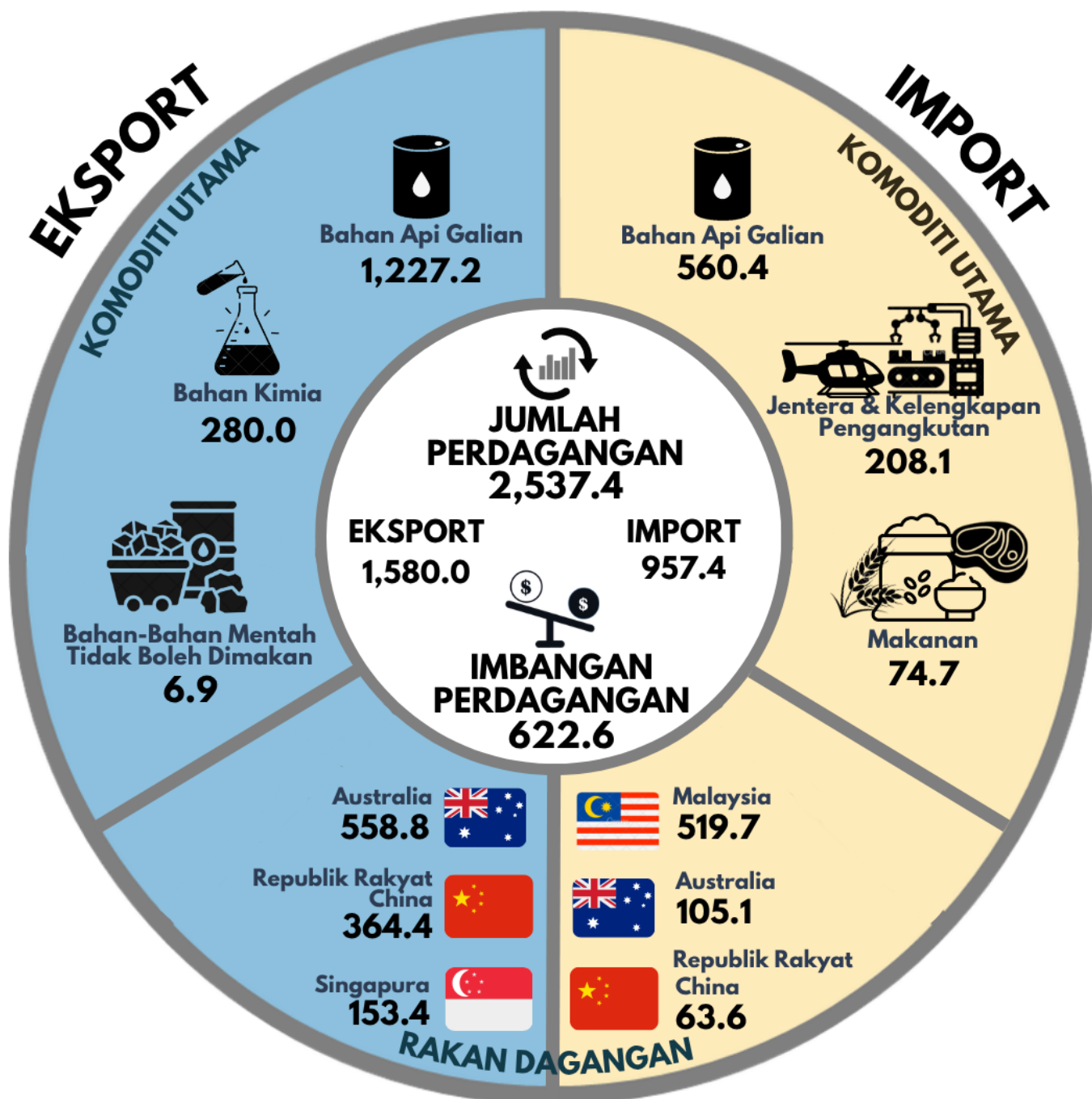

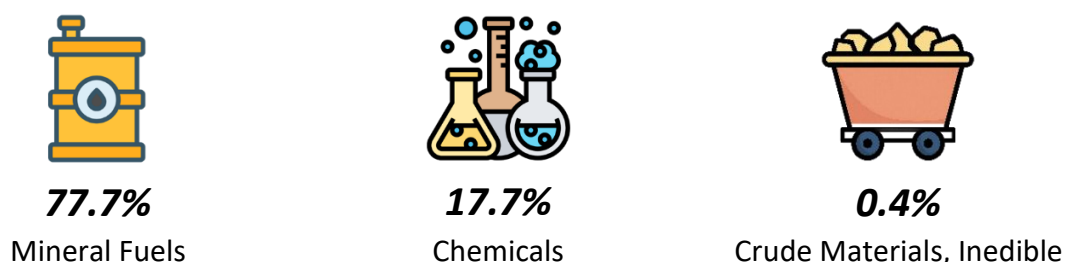

Trade Balance Surplus Increased in June 2026

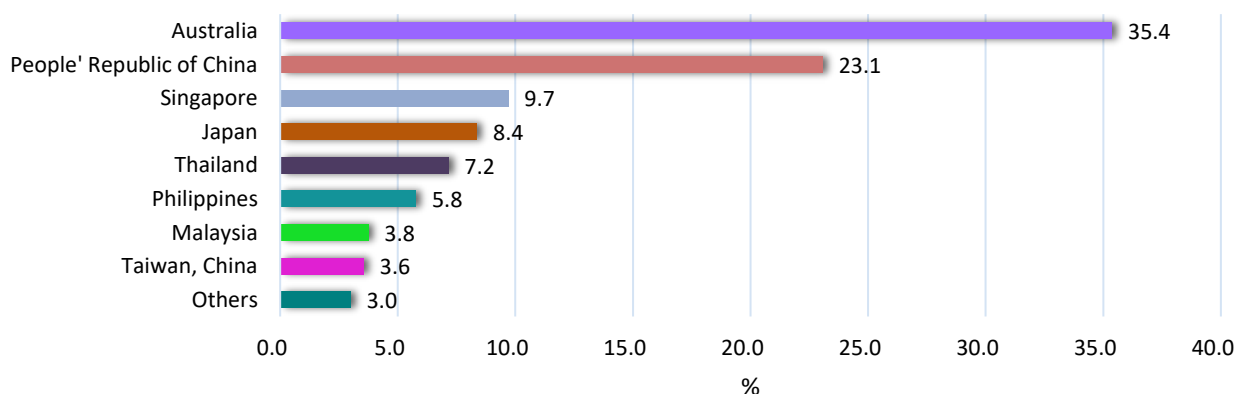
1. The trade balance recorded a surplus of BND622.6 million, an increase of 112.8 per cent, compared to June 2025. The increase was mainly driven by increases in exports by 66.7 per cent. The value of imports also increased by 46.2 per cent.
2. Both exports and imports contributed to strong trade performance, with total trade increasing by 58.3 per cent to BND2,537.4 million. Total exports amounted to BND1,580.0 million, primarily contributed by Mineral Fuels; Chemicals; and Crude Materials, Inedible.

Share of Main Exports by Commodity



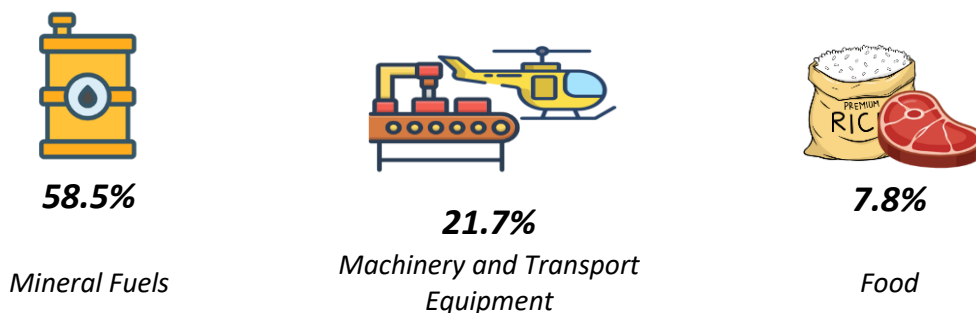
3. The main export markets were Australia accounting for 35.4 per cent, followed by the People's Republic of China and Singapore at 23.1 per cent and 9.7 per cent, respectively. The largest export commodity to these countries was Mineral Fuels.

4. Meanwhile, total imports value amounted to BND957.4 million, mainly contributed by Mineral Fuels; Machinery and Transport Equipment; and Food.

5. The largest import partners were Malaysia, accounting for 54.3 per cent, followed by Australia at 11.0 per cent, and the People's Republic of China at 6.6 per cent. The main import commodities from these countries were Mineral Fuels, and Machinery and Transport Equipment, specifically helicopter.
6. The imports by end-use categories were mainly used for the processing of Intermediate Goods accounting for 57.1 per cent, followed by Capital Goods for business operations at 39.2 per cent, and Consumption Goods for household use at 3.7 per cent.
7. Compared to May 2026, the trade surplus increased by 36.2 per cent, driven by a 0.4 per cent increase in exports, while total imports recorded a decrease by 14.3 per cent. Consequently, total trade also recorded a decrease of 5.7 per cent.
