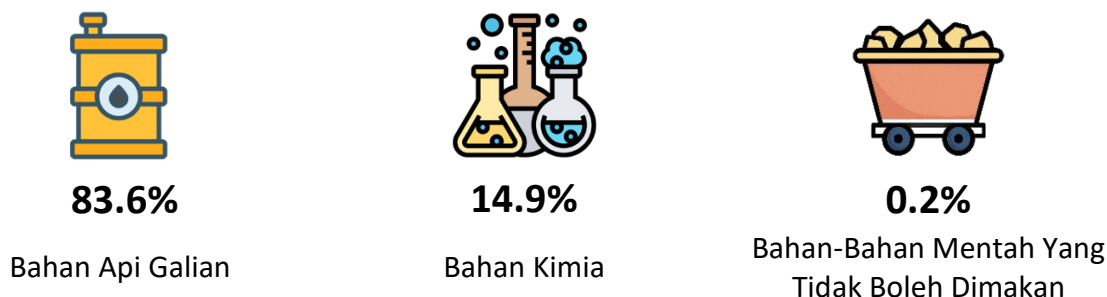

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**Lebih Imbangan Perdagangan Meningkat pada Mei 2026**

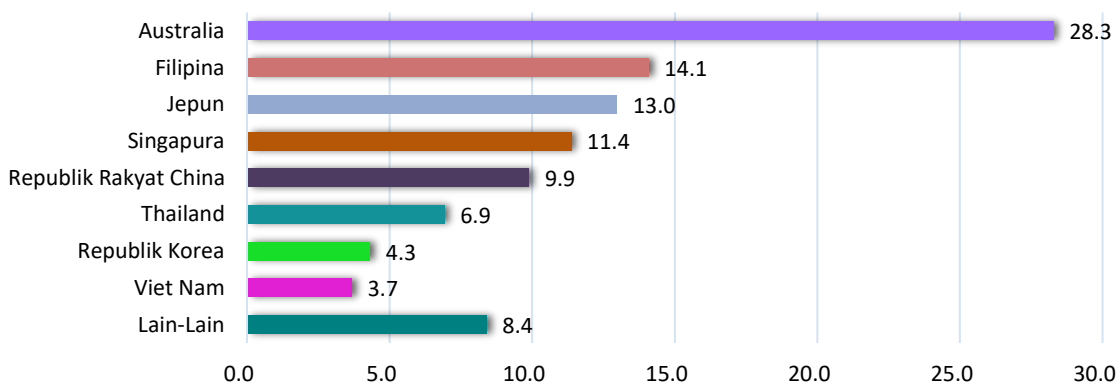
1. Imbangan perdagangan mencatatkan lebih BND457.2 juta iaitu meningkat sebanyak 79.6 peratus, berbanding bulan Mei 2025. Peningkatan ini didorong terutamanya oleh peningkatan eksport dan import masing-masing sebanyak 52.8 peratus dan 44.0 peratus.
2. Kedua-dua eksport dan import menyumbang kepada prestasi perdagangan yang kukuh, dengan jumlah perdagangan meningkat sebanyak 49.0 peratus kepada BND2,690.8 juta. Jumlah eksport sebanyak BND1,574.0 juta, terutamanya disumbangkan oleh Bahan Api Galian; Bahan Kimia; dan Bahan-Bahan Mentah Yang Tidak Boleh Dimakan.

3. Pasaran eksport utama adalah Australia sebanyak 28.3 peratus, diikuti oleh Filipina dan Jepun, masing-masing sebanyak 14.1 peratus dan 13.0 peratus. Komoditi eksport terbesar ke negara-negara tersebut adalah Bahan Api Galian.

4. Manakala, jumlah nilai import adalah sebanyak BND1,116.8 juta, terutamanya disumbangkan oleh Bahan Api Galian; Jentera dan kelengkapan Pengangkutan; dan Makanan.

5. Sumbangan terbesar rakan dagangan import adalah dari Malaysia sebanyak 69.5 peratus, diikuti oleh Australia sebanyak 10.5 peratus, dan Viet Nam sebanyak 4.9 peratus. Komoditi import utama daripada rakan dagangan adalah Bahan Api Galian.
6. Import mengikut kategori penggunaan akhir digunakan untuk pemprosesan Barangan Perantaraan sebanyak 57.3 peratus, diikuti oleh Barangan Modal bagi operasi perniagaan sebanyak 40.5 peratus, dan Barangan Penggunaan bagi kegunaan isi rumah sebanyak 2.2 peratus.
7. Berbanding bulan April 2026, lebihan imbalan perdagangan menurun sebanyak 59.1 peratus, terutamanya didorong oleh penurunan jumlah eksport sebanyak 23.5 peratus dan peningkatan jumlah import sebanyak 19.1 peratus. Perkembangan ini turut menyebabkan jumlah perdagangan mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 10.1 peratus.

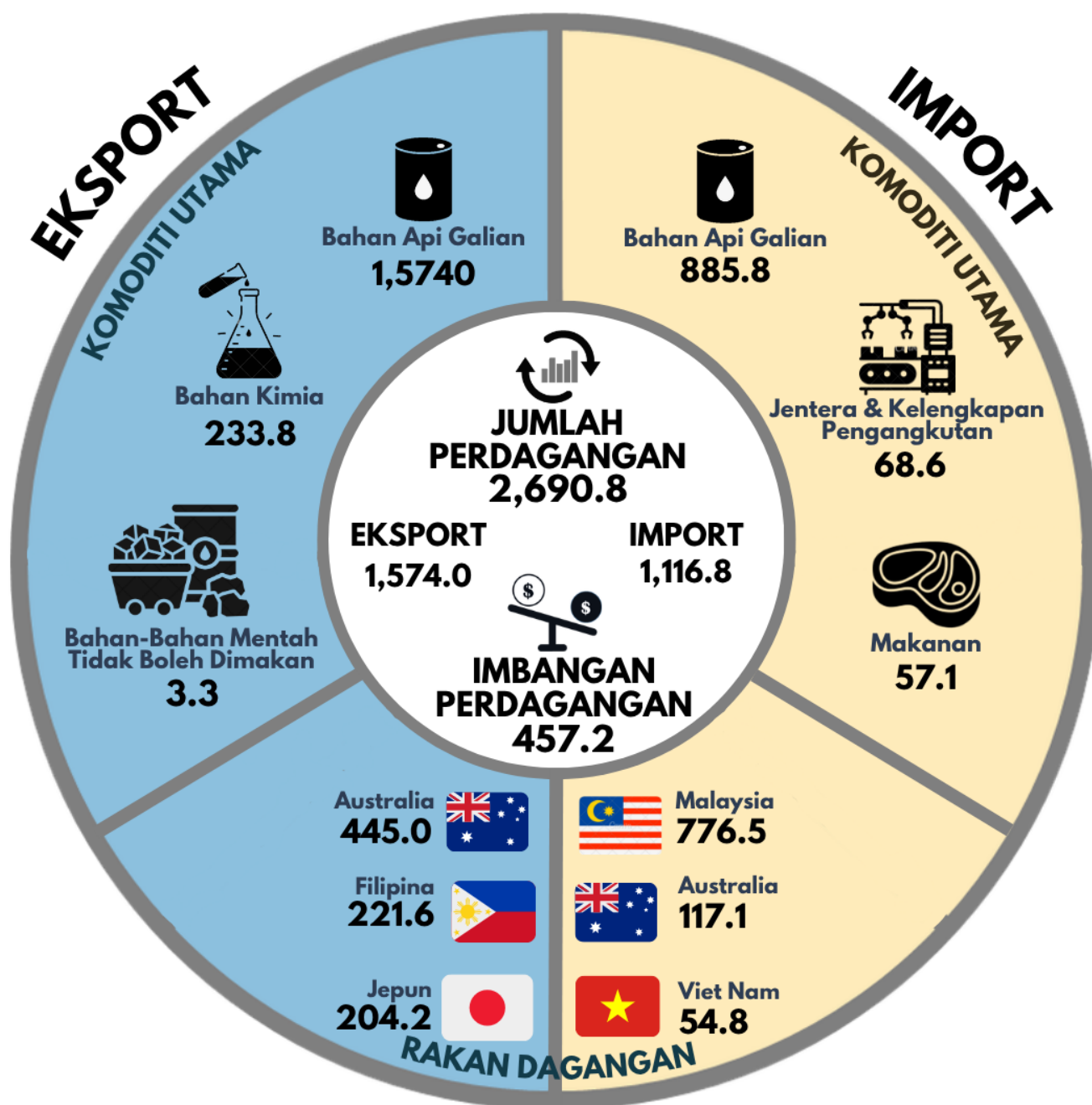

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***Trade Balance Surplus Increased in May 2026***

1. The trade balance recorded a surplus of BND457.2 million, an increase of 79.6 per cent, compared to May 2025. The increase was mainly driven by increases in exports and imports by 52.8 per cent and 44.0 per cent respectively.
2. Both exports and imports contributed to strong trade performance, with total trade increasing by 49.0 per cent to BND2,690.8 million. Total exports amounted to BND1,574.0 million, primarily contributed by Mineral Fuels; Chemicals; and Crude Materials, Inedible.

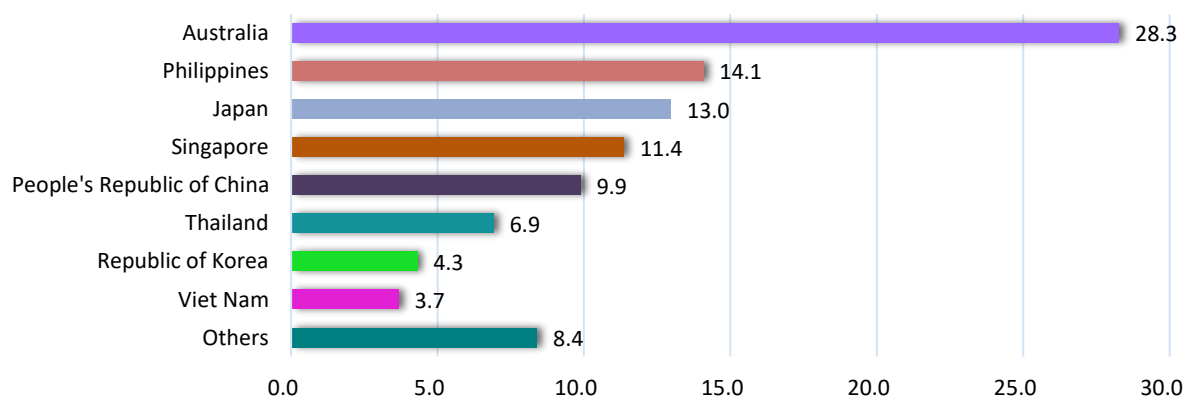

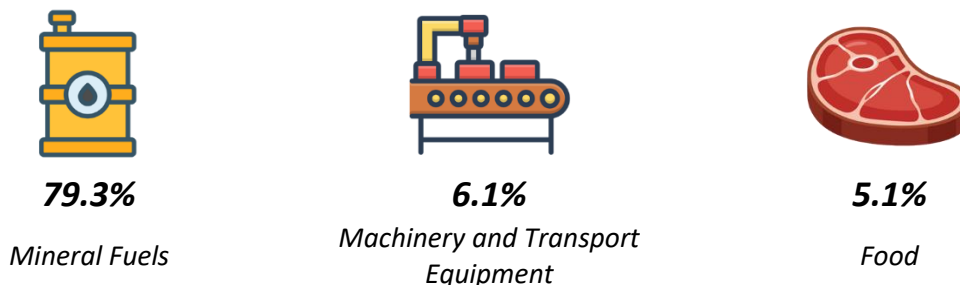
3. The main export markets were Australia accounting for 28.3 per cent, followed by Phillipines and Japan at 14.1 per cent and 13.0 per cent, respectively. The largest export commodity to these countries was Mineral Fuels.

4. Meanwhile, total imports value amounted to BND1,116.8 million, mainly contributed by Mineral Fuels; Machinery and Transport Equipment; and Food.

5. The largest import partners were Malaysia, accounting for 69.5 per cent, followed by Australia at 10.5 per cent, and Vietnam at 4.9 per cent. The main import commodities from these countries were Mineral Fuels.
6. The imports by end-use categories were mainly used for the processing of Intermediate Goods accounting for 57.3 per cent, followed by Capital Goods for business operations at 40.5 per cent, and Consumption Goods for household use at 2.2 per cent.
7. Compared to April 2026, the trade surplus decreased by 59.1 per cent, driven by a 23.5 per cent decrease in exports and a 19.1 per cent increase in imports. Consequently, total trade also recorded a 10.1 per cent decline.
